

**JEWISH NEWS BRIEFS**

**NEW YORK** ---The National Women's Division of the American Jewish Congress celebrated the 50th anniversary of passage of the 19th Amendment -- which gave U.S. women the right to vote -- with a call for fulfillment of its "inherent promise of equal opportunity for women."

**TEL AV IV (WNS)**--The Palestinian National Council met in Amman to consider strategy in view of the initiation of peace talks in the United Nations. El Fatah spokesmen said delegates from the American New Left and the Black Panthers Party, and from Communist China, North Korea and North Vietnam participated in council sessions to help find ways to "foil" the "conspiracy" of the peace negotiations.

**NEW YORK** ---Among the 430 Americans sailing on August 24th from New York on the Greek liner, Anna Maria, the largest single group of Americans to go on aliyah, were 75 professionals, 23 skilled and semiskilled workers, and 8 businessmen.

**NEW YORK**---52 American and Canadian students, most of them members of Zionist youth movements, left Tuesday, September 1, for Israel to spend a year of study and work there. The study program for the students at the Institute for Jewish Youth Leaders from abroad in Jerusalem is administered by the Youth and Hechalutz Department of the World Zionist Organization. The program in the United States is under the auspices of the American Zionist Youth Foundation.

**LOS ANGELES**---Tens of thousands of greeting cards for the Jewish New Year will be mailed from all of the major cities of the USA, Canada and Latin America to over 200 Russian Jews who have openly demanded that their government permit them to leave the country in accordance with the Universal Declaration of Human Rights which was passed by the United Nations and signed by the USSR. The Union of Councils for Soviet Jews, a national organization, is sponsoring the card campaign which will be conducted in Southern California by the So. Cal. Council for Soviet Jews and the California Students for Soviet Jews.

**NEW YORK**---The immediate aim of the Black Panther party is to stimulate a wave of "real repression" in the United States as a prelude to revolutionary war, according to an article by Tom Milstein in the September issue of Commentary magazine.

**JERUSALEM (WNS)**---Non-Zionist leaders from three continents signed an agreement with leaders of the World Zionist Organization which granted Zionists and non-Zionists equal representation the reconstituted Jewish Agency.

**GENEVA (WNS)**---The International Red Cross advised Israel it had been permitted to see two Israeli prisoners, Itzhak Peer and Amos Zamir, who had been prisoners for 50 days
