### PEACE TALKS

#### PEACE TALKS BEGIN

United Nations (WNS)- Talks of a "just and lasting peace" in the Middle East got under way when United Nations Mediator Gunnar V. Jarring met separately with Ambassadors from Israel, Egypt and Jordan.

The talks began just 18 days after the United States sponsored cease fire went into effect.

After meeting twice with Dr. Jarring, Israeli Ambassador to the UN Yosef Tekoah, left for Israel for consultations with his government.

Also meeting with Dr. Jarring was Jordan's Ambassador to the US, Abdul Hamid Sheref, who was filling in for Muhammed H. el-Farra the Jordanian U. N. Ambassador who is in Amman for consultation and with Egyptian Ambassador to the U.N., Mohammed el-Zayyat.

Before leaving for Israel, Mr. Tekoah told the press he had presented Dr. Jarring with Israel's basic position on peace in the Middle East. (Israel would withdraw from occupied territories to secure, recognized and agreed boundaries to be determined in the peace agreements.) It was reported that Mr. Tekoah had raised the question of Egyptian violations of the standstill cease-fire and had told Dr. Jarring that if the Arabs wanted to show good faith they could begin by releasing Israeli prisoners.

(Israel has offered to exchange the 117 Arab POW's it holds for the 17 Israelis, including three civilians, held by the Arabs.)

Sources at the U. N. reported that Dr. Jarring replied that it was not part of his

mandate under Security Council Resolution 242 of November 1967 to intercede on behalf of Israeli prisoners now held by the Arabs. U.N. Spokesmen did confirm, however, that Dr. Jarring had intervened in 1968 to secure the release of Arab consuls who were being held prisoners by Israel after meeting with Dr. Jarring, angrily denied that Egypt had violated the cease-fire and charged in turn that Israel had violated the cease fire only three hours after it went into effect and was continuing to violate it by bringing in troops and building new roads and fortifications. He also agreed with Dr. Jarring that the prisoner problem was not part of Dr. Jarring's mission. With Mr. Tekoah in Israel, talks slowed to a standstill and a news blackout was imposed as the peace talks entered the third day. No meetings were reported to have been held or scheduled.

Reportedly, the Arabs were angered by Mr. Tekoah's absence regarding it as evidence of "Israeli footdragging and a diplomatic source said his absence could have a negative effect on peace negotiations. Western diplomatic sources called his return for consultations, "legitimate and understandable" pointing out that Jordan's Ambassador was at home for consultations.

Meanwhile, the Western

White House at San Clemente, Cal. released the transcript of a background briefing that was held for Western newspaper editors and publishers at which US officials said the US was willing to join with the Soviet Union in a two-nation enforcement of a Middle East peace

settlement. The US-Soviet peace keeping force would not come into being until a peace settlement was reached at the UN.
