his scorn for the Vatican to win election to the Northern Ireland Parliament as well as to the British Parliament. In today's fierce struggle by Northern Ireland's 550,000 Catholics to win economic equality with that area's 950,000 Protestants, Ian Paisley has never hesitated to denounce Catholicism with furious words. The Pope for Paisley is "that whore of Babylon". His denigration of Catholic doctrine and aspirations generates political support just as it stiffens the determination of Ulster's Catholics to rally behind Bernadette Devlin and fight on for an end to housing and job discrimination.

Carl McIntire's anti-Catholicism may be more inhibited than his Irish counterpart; but he has hammered it home to the faithful in his churches, schools and associations. Twenty-five years ago, he offered this appraisal: "As we enter the post-war world, without any doubt the greatest enemy of freedom and liberty that the world has to face today is the Roman Catholic terror. The sooner the Christian people of America wake up to this danger, the safer will be our land."

Late last year, Carl McIntire was removed from the executive committee of the American Council of Christian Churches, the rump organization he had founded in 1941 in his determination to downgrade efforts by the National Council of Churches and World Council of Churches to harness the power of the pulpit to the kind of machinery best calculated to wipe out poverty and feed the hungry. Characteristically, McIntire, within a day or two, announced that he was launching a new fundamentalist body, the American Christian Action Council.

It is instructive to observe the nature of Dr. McIntire's support. Last October when the New Jersey state government threatened to close out accreditation for Shelton College on the grounds that that institution, with Dr. McIntire as its President, had a low academic standing, Governor Lester Maddox of Georgia flew to Trenton to stand by the Protestant fundamentalist.

This spring, when Dr. McIntire led a "March For Victory" down Pennsylvania Avenue in Washington, he read a message of support from Alabama's George Wallace and drew the backing of Senator Strom Thurmond, Congressman Mendel Rivers, John Stormer (author of "None Dare Call It Treason"), and leaders of such units as Liberty Lobby and the American Coalition of Patriotic Societies.

May America continue its ability to absorb McIntirism. And may Belfast, which has suffered far too much these past few years, find a way to curb the excesses of Paisleyism.

President Nixon could very well culminate with the announcement that the Peace Talks are over. Israel then would not be violating any negotiations by resuming its defense of the Suez Canal border where the Egyptians and Russians are building up to a major offensive.

About the hijackings: It is common knowledge that the Russians have been supplying arms, munitions, finance and tactical assistance to the guerrillas since the 6 - Day War.

The terrorist groups are highly organized, fully equipped and ready for action, without jeopardy of any reprisals from nations of the world. The Arab governments, in mock aloofness of the insanities being committed by the guerrillas, retain their standings among nations. Egypt and Jordan and Lebanon and Syria, and the rest, sit in conference and pass themselves off as legitimate governments while criminal agents commit outrageous practices under their very noses.

Make no mistake about it, Israel is very well aware of what is taking place. When a man like Abba Eban loses his cool and burst into a fit of temper publicly, the whole world may be put on notice that something is about to happen.

The Arab - Russian bloc cannot keep up the subterfuge any longer. When a huge, jet passenger plane is flown into Cairo Airport, and the passengers are given eight minutes to get off before the craft is blown up, you cannot tell this column or any thinking person with an ounce of brains that the Egyptian government and the Egyptian army did not purposely keep hands off on the matter. Who does Nasser and the Russians think they are kidding?

When three other planes are landed at a "desert landing field" just 25 miles from Amman and the passengers held captive for days, no one can convince us the Jordanian government was not part and parcel in the plot. These were not acts committed in Israel against Israelis. These were violences of tyranny in planes of and in the air over neutral countries, who presumably maintain friendly relations with the Arabs. Who's kidding who?

What right have delegates from Egypt, Syria, Jordan, Lebanon and the others including Red Russia, to sit at the sessions of the United Nations in the guise of promoting world peace when they support international violations? Here are Britain, Switzerland and West Germany about to release seven Palestinian terrorists being held in those countries for acts of violence, in exchange for the release of persons held by "Arab terrorists". They are Arab terrorists, of course, but for any control being exercised over their criminal acts, they might just as well be part of the Arab government just as well be part of the Arab government armies.

If the so called legitimate and recognized Arab governments cannot or will not properly police their own nations, someone will have to do it, and that someone has to be Israel. What would happen if a renegade band of outlaws attacked the United Nations and captured a number of delegates from foreign countries, while the New York Police Force stood by and watched? You can bet there would be a hue and cry against the U.S. Government. That's exactly what is taking place in the Mideast, while the rest of the world is biting its nails.

Israel reluctantly went along with President Nixon's honest effort to bring peace to the Mideast. The Arabs, guided by the Russians, grabbed at the opportunity of cease fire to strengthen their position along the Suez. It was pre-ordained that the Arab guerrillas should publicly not go along with the Arab agreement of cease fire, so that the terrorists could continue the acts of violence unmolested.

Don't you think Israel is cognizant of these circumstances? Don't you think Israel knows how to cope with them? If you don't think so, you're stupid?

Arab Myths

Regardless of the outcome, some myths must be laid to rest resulting from the Arab guerrilla hijacking of recent international flights. In the first place, Arab contentions that they are not anti - Semitic but anti - Zionist were shattered when the hostages were separated into Jews and non - Jews. If anti - Semitism were not the issue, why the separation? Anti-zionism as a doctrine might hold water in the middle east but not beyond, where the concept requires some historical sophistication among non-Jews.

Secondly, there is a lesson to be learned in the results of the hijacking attempts. Four were successful but the fifth was foiled by El Al personnel. It leads to a conclusion that the personnel of most international flights are professional people whose major concern is safety and service. The Israeli crew, so bound up with their own country's destiny, are committed to defense. This means they will take an action other international personnel might and would not. Until now, hijacking has been an inconvenience so perhaps the conciliation to hijack demands has been a good policy. But now, with the blowing up of the PANAM liner in Cairo, and the holding of innocent hostages, perhaps there will be a different look at these attempts. Perhaps resistance will be necessary in addition to preliminary cautions before flight.

Irish Quarrels

Involvement of certain Americans in Northern Ireland's bitter religious and political conflict, pitting 23 - year old Bernadette Devlin against Rev. Ian Paisley, 44, provides sharp and clear insights into international alliances among modern fundamentalists.

Rev. Carl McIntire, whose American Council of Churches has provided him a far - ranging pulpit for attacks upon progressive Protestants for many years, has been cheering Ian Paisley on with inordinate passion. The New Jersey fundamentalist has been at the side of the Belfast extremist during the troubled days in Northern Ireland; and when Ian Paisley came to the United States to try to gain sympathy and support for his dubious cause a year ago, Carl McIntire was at his side.

This partnership reflects the contempt shown by both of these vigorous and rigid churchmen against earnest efforts to end religious quarrels and to get on with the advancement of civil rights and human understanding.

At the heart of the Paisley - McIntire view of the world is a harsh judgement of Roman Catholicism. The Irish Protestant employs
