It was re-ported that the homes of the four were searched and several volumes of the Jewish Encyclopedia were seized although there is no ban against the publication. Shortly before the arrests became known, a delegation of Canadian

Jewish leaders had met with Premier Pierre Elliot Trudeau and For-eign Secretary Mitchell Sharp and unged the Premier to appeal to Russian leaders on his visit to Moscow next month to allow Jews who wish to go to Israel to emigrate. And as the arrests


