**TABER FOR SUP. CT. JUDGE**

The man with the little case should get the same brand of justice as the man with the big case, according to the state's strongest advocate of court modernization.

Harold O. Taber, candidate for Nevada Supreme Court Justice, told the Boulder Rotary Club:

"Some talk about reform. I'm talking about common sense in our courts - and that's what most Nevadans want."

Taber said, "Nevadans have had it with justice delayed." He urged legislative adoption of a constitutional amendment providing for constructively changes in the state's court system. Taber chaired the Citizens Conferences on the Nevada Court System which recommended the modernization.

Taber pledged "my most strenuous efforts" to take the Nevada judicial structure "out of the horse-and-buggy days". The high court candidate declared that "justice is everybody's business and it's about time everyone had their fair share of justice."

The former Nevada district attorney, state judge and now private counsel, called for creation of county judgeships and a new role for justices of the peace as magistrates.

Establishment of a judicial discipline commission is among key provisions of the constitutional amendment backed by Taber. The commission would have authority to discipline errant

judges right to the point of removing them from office. Taber said the very existence of such commissions in other states has led to wayward judges resigning rather than facing up to official sanctions for misconduct.

The entire modernization program, Taber said, must be tied together with a plan for more business-like administration of the courts.

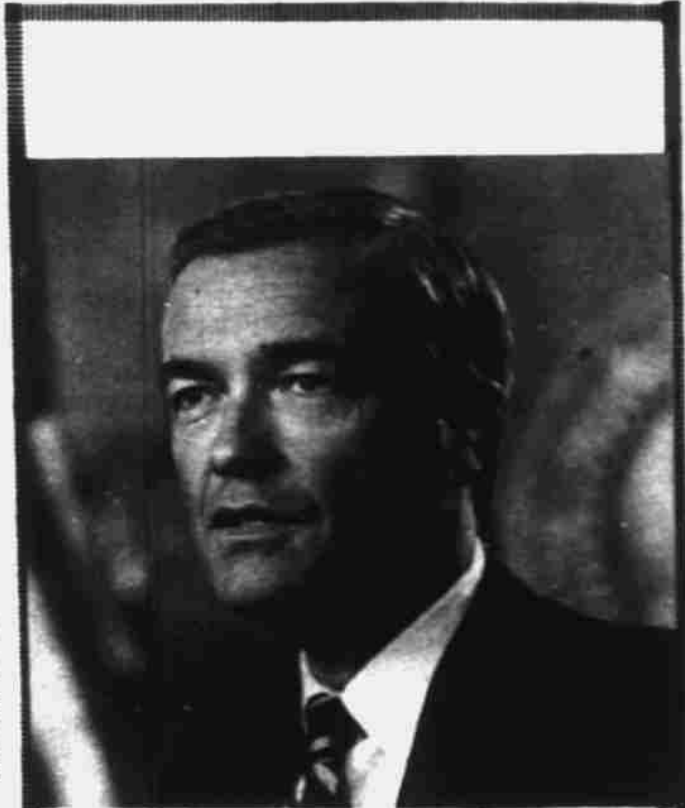
