MAJ. KAYE HONORED BY JWV AT DINNER IN ALADDIN HOTEL

Major Sidney H. Kaye, who raised almost \$50,000 for the Beersheba Rest Home for Israeli soldiers, was guest of honor at the Commander's Banquet of the Sixth Region Executive Committee of the Jewish War Veterans. The affair was held last Saturday at the Aladdin Hotel.

On hand to honor Maj. Kaye were Nevada's U.S. Senators Alan Bible and Howard Cannon and State Senator Chic Hect, along with L.V. B'nai B'rith President Nat Hart.

Billy Daniels, one of the most versatile singers of all time provided a musical interlude.

The honors accorded Maj. Kaye highlight a lifetime of service. More than 20 years ago he was installer and charter member J.W.V. Post 396 in Los Angeles and a member of Post 113. He was a founder of Las Vegas Post 711 and very active in veteran and community affairs in Nevada for many years.

Born and raised in Montreal, he is now an American citizen. He was educated in Canada and England.

During World War I he served with the British Imperial Forces, including assignments to Belgium, France and India. He

participated in the Gallipoli landing. He also trained and served with the Jewish Brigade. He retired with rank of Major.

After coming to the United States he became active in real estate investment counseling and accounting. He is a Trustee of the Federal Court. He helped build the Royal Nevada Hotel, was on the first Board of Directors and was Operations Director. He was appointed property custodian by the B'nai B'rith of Las Vegas in 1956.

During World War II he had special assignments by Robert R. Patterson, Secretary of War, and also has been military attache to the Ambassador of Norway.
