

NEW YORK — The continuing ferment in the Middle East echoes and re-echoes throughout North Africa and Europe disrupting centuries-old Jewish communities and keeping tens of thousands of Jews in a constant state of anxiety, in some instances terror, Louis D. Horwitz, Director-General of the Joint Distribution Committee reported to over 300 Jewish leaders from the United States and Canada.

NEW YORK — A Canadian-Israeli air agreement calling for 4 flights a week between Montreal and Lod by each of the country's carriers, Canadian Pacific Airways and El Al, are expected to start by April 1, 1971.

NEW YORK — Thousands of New York Jews stormed the doors of the Hunter College Assembly Hall Sunday evening, October 18, seeking entrance to the "Festival of Redemption" for Russian Jewry organized by the Student Struggle for Soviet Jewry, under the general auspices of the New York Conference on Soviet Jewry. When matters settled down, each of the Hall's 2300 seats was filled, and hundreds others stood or sat in aisles and steps.

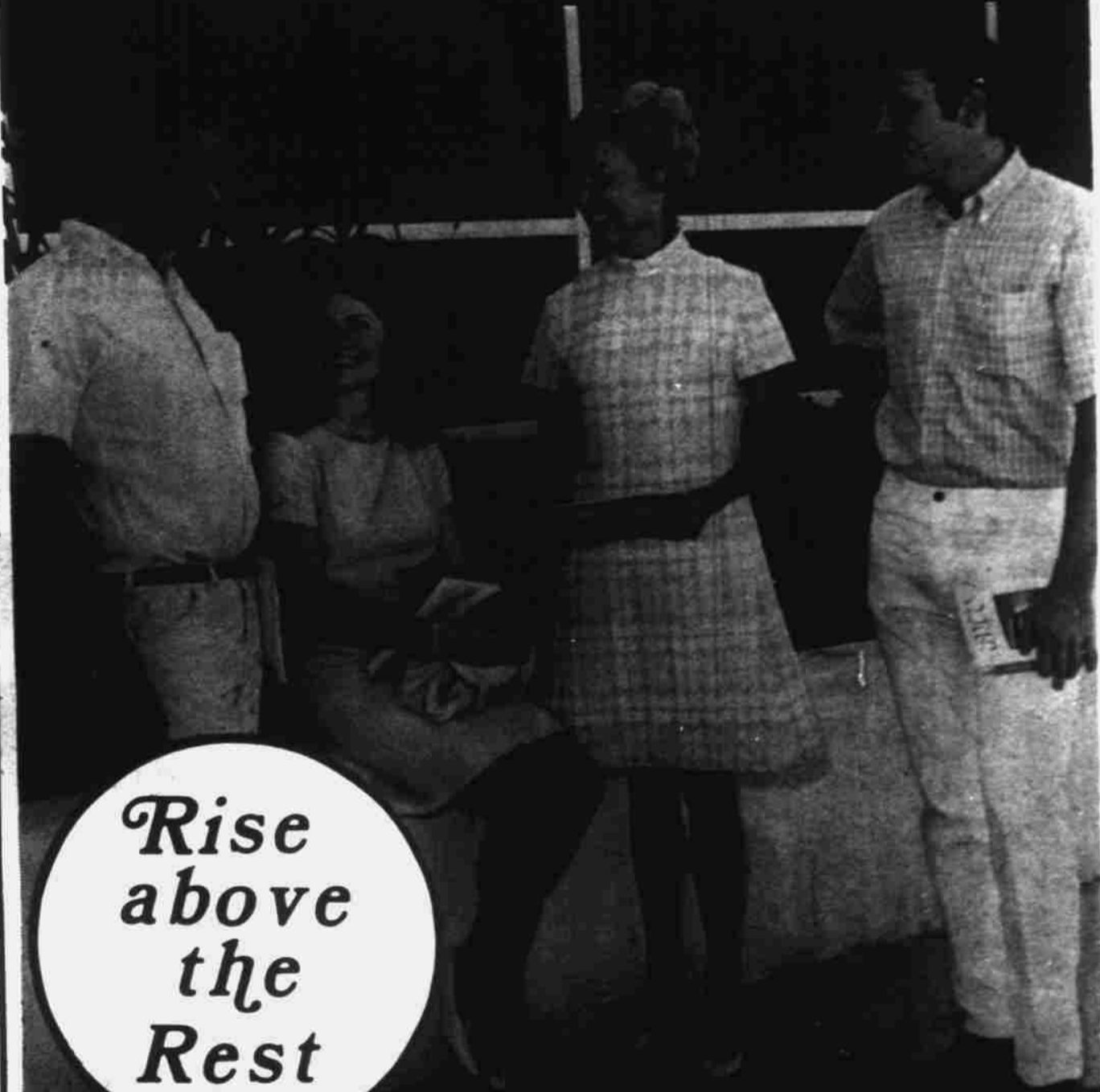
