How can we resist these whirlwinds which rage about us? First, we must refuse to believe that what is spotlighted is necessarily representative of society. Often the fringes are shown on the media or highlighted in the press and we bet the false notion that everyone is engulfed in volatile activities.

As a number of writers have conselled us, remember that the bulk of society does not indulge in maybem or deviation. We need perspective badly.
