land, sea and air by student demonstrators demanding justice for Soviet Jews. While in Jacksonville, Fla., Mayor Hans G. Tanzler Jr. designated December as "Human Rights for Jews of the Soviet Union Month."

The Socialist International in Stockholm published a report likening Soviet anti-Semitism to that which prevailed in the Fascist countries during the 1930's, and in Buenos Aires, the Federation of Zionist Students of Latin America condemned the Soviet policy of denying Jews the right to emigrate to Israel and urged the United Nations to intercede on behalf of the Soviet Jewry.

In London, 500 persons protesting the treatment of Soviet Jews were addressed by Monsgr. Francis Bartlett, representing John Cardinal Heenan, Roman Catholic Primate of England, while in Manchester, 500 students passed out leaflets outside the Town Hall decrying the plight of Soviet Jews while inside, a Soviet Embassy spokesman addressed the Manchester Central Branch of the United Nations Association.

Peace Corps Jewish volunteers serving in the Philippines, Nigeria, Peru, the Caroline Islands and other far off places will also be lighting Hanukkah candles and opening gifts received from the JWB Women's Organizations' Services.

Hanukkah gifts, menorahs, candles and decorations have been sent to the 17 USO Clubs in Vietnam and Thailand to bring the holiday feeling to the Jewish men during their leisure hours.

The Women's Organizations' Services is composed of the following nine national Jewish women's groups: Hadassah, National Bureau of Federated Women's Organizations, National Council of Jewish Women, National Federation of Temple Sisterhoods, National JWB Jewish Community Center Services, National Women's League of the United Synagogue of America, United Order of True Sisters, the Women's Branch of the Union of Orthodox Jewish Congregations of America and the Women's Division of the American Jewish Congress.

JWB is the agency accredited by the U.S. Defense Department to meet the religious, morale and welfare needs of Jewish military personnel, their dependents and hospitalized veterans. It is a beneficiary of the United Jewish Appeal of Greater New York and of hundreds of Jewish federations and welfare funds outside of New York. JWB is a member agency of USO.
