

NEW YORK - Sixty-six students, now in graduate schools of social work under 84 scholarship and fellowship grants valued at \$166,400, are planning careers in Jewish Community Centers, it is announced by Morton L. Mandel, president of the National Jewish Welfare Board.

ST. LOUIS - The "Arab vendetta" against Israel, however strong and deep, would be no obstacle to peace "if it were not deliberately fed by the Soviet Union," the director of the B'nai B'rith International Council, Herman Edelsberg told a conference of St. Louis Jewish communal leaders.

WASHINGTON - The craftsmanship of the first known Jewish silversmith in America Myer Myers, a contemporary of Paul Revere, went on display this week at the Klutznick Exhibit Hall of the B'nai B'rith Building here.

ISRAEL, JEWRY INSOLUBLY LINKED

WASHINGTON, D.C. (WNS)--Rabbi Dr. Jacob Vainstein, president of the Religious Council of Jerusalem, told the Union of Orthodox Jewish Congregations that "Israel and Diaspora Jewry are two arms of one and the same body whose fate is insolubly bound together."

He told the 2,000 delegates attending the final session of the 72nd biennial convention that Israel's "unique" contribution is "its religious and spiritual heritage," and "the basis of the unity of its people the world over is Torah and the special

Judaic way of life." And he added, "The national and religious elements in the new land are inseparable, and this is the distinctive mark that makes Medinat Israel a Jewish State."

Rabbi Vainstein called on America's Jews to "invest a maximum effort in the Jewish education of their young and set the correct example for them." He said that Jewish youth, like non-Jewish youth, were attracted to the New Left because it seemed more relevant to today's society than the assimilation of their parents.

NEW YORK - Political action by synagogue forces, Jewish identity, and new generation realities are among the key discussions highlighting the 72nd Anniversary National Biennial Convention of the Union of Orthodox Jewish Congregations of America, to be held in Washington, D.C. from November 25 through November 29, as announced by Lawrence A. Kobrin, General Convention Chairman.

NEW YORK - 1500 North Americans and Europeans are presently enrolled in Israeli Yeshivot (higher academies of Jewish learning), it was announced by Zvi Assael, director of the Torah Education and Culture Department of the Jewish Agency-American Section. This marks a great increase over the past years: 1967 saw 330 such students, 917 in 1968 and 1210 in 1969. This figure does not include those studying in secular colleges and universities in Israel.

NEW YORK - While a leading Negro newspaper editor in St. Louis explained the reasons for a "rising tide of pro-Arab feeling" in the black community, and Whitney Young, executive director of the Urban League rejected the "myth of Arab-Black friendship" in calling for support of Israel, a group of 50 black militants attacked U.S. support for the "Zionist Government of Israel" in a half-page advertisement in the Sunday edition of the New York Times.

TEL AVIV (WNS)-- Dewey D. Stone, 70, Chairman of the Board of Governors of the Weizmann Institute and Harry Levine, 75, a founding governor and treasurer of the American Committee of the Weizmann Institute in New York, were honored

at a dinner at the Weizmann Institute of Science at Rehoboth on their birthdays.

Premier Golda Meir said "I can think of no two other American Jews who have done for Israel what Dewey Stone and Harry Levine did and are still doing."
