1ST ENGLISH OLD TESTAMENT

NEW YORK-- "The Psalms for Modern Man" is being published by the American Bible Society as the first complete Old Testament book in Today's English Version.

The volume of 150 sacred songs or hymns thus joins "Good News for Modern Man," the New Testament in Today's English Version, which the Society published September 15, 1966.

A volume containing both the third edition of "Good News for Modern Man" and the Psalms, will be published early in 1971. The New Testament has had the phenomenal distribution of more than 23 million copies in the United States since it made its first appearance four years ago.

Annie Vallotton of Paris, the noted Swiss artist whose line drawings in "Good News for Modern Man" were so enthusiastically received, is the illustrator of "The Psalms for Modern Man."

The Rev. Dr. Robert G. Bratcher of Setauket, N. Y., is chairman of The Today's English Version Old Testament Committee, a group of scholars who already have devoted more than two years of effort to translating the Old Testament into modern-day English. The complete Old Testament is slated to be published in 1975.

Other members of the Committee are: the Rev. Dr. Roger A. Bul-

lard of Wilson, N. C.; the Rev. Dr. Keith R. Crim, Richmond, Va.; the Rev. Dr. Herbert Grether of Berkeley, Calif., missionary to Thailand on leave of absence; and the Rev. Dr. Barclay Newman of Black Mountain, N. C. All are full-time translators except Dr. Bullard, who works with the committee part-time.

The committee members work with the most authoritative Hebrew text available, Biblia Hebraica, edited by Rudolf Kittel in preparing the separate books of the Old Testament.

The TEV Old Testament Committee completed the translation of the Psalms. Their work was then carefully reviewed by various members of the staff of the Translations Department, including a number of Translations Consultants overseas. It also was submitted to members of the Translations Committee of the American Bible Society who were designated by that Committee to represent them in consultation on the TEV Old Testament text.

A semi-final form of this text was submitted to all members of the Translations Committee for their review.

"The Psalms for Modern Man," available now from the Society, will sell for 10 cents. "Good News for Modern Man with the Psalms," to be available early in 1971, is priced at 50 cents. Both are paperback editions.

The American Bible Society, 1865 Broadway, N. Y. C. 10023, a non-profit organization which was founded in 1816, has as its object the translation, publication and distribution of the Scriptures, without note or comment, to men everywhere in a language they can read or understand at a price they can afford.
