Once a rabbi was fired from his job because in his bulletin he kept a score of those members of the board of trustees who attended services on Friday night.

But no one can fault the rabbi of Beth Tzedec Congregation in Toronto for some statistics he ran in his bulletin.

Let me remind you, if you don't already know, that Beth Tzedec is one of the most beautiful Jewish sanctuaries on the continent. It is on famed Bathurst Street which, like Baltimore's Park Heights Avenue, has so many

synagogues it's called Rue de la Pavess. And let me remind, if you don't already know, that the rabbi of this enormous synagogue is Dr. Stuart Rosenberg, one of the most eloquent and erudite Conservative spiritual leaders of our time.

In his bulletin Rabbi Rosenberg reprinted a report he received from William Crocker, a trustee, giving some data about synagogue attendance. The chart reads as follows:
