WASHINGTON -- Nevada Sen. Howard W. Cannon won assurance from the top tourism official in the Nixon Administration that Las Vegas will receive priority consideration in a new federal grants program to bring foreign travel to the United States.

OPERA HOPEFULS

A spring vocalists inclined toward a career in opera are invited to audition for the Metropolitan Opera Company at 1 p.m. Feb. 13 at the University of Nevada, Las Vegas.

Applications may be secured from Dr. Howard Chase, professor of music at UNLV.

Sponsored annually by the Metropolitan Opera National Council, auditions begin on a local level and proceed to regional and national levels. Winners in all categories are eligible for cash awards with possibilities of Met contracts open to national finalists.

Although professional experience is not required, Chase commented, applicants must be sponsored by a voice instructor or educational institution and should display vocal talent, adequate voice training, musical background and artistic aptitude.

Applicants must be within certain age limits during the period between Jan. 1 and April 15. Sopranos must be 18 to 30 years old, mezzos and contraltos 20 to 30, tenors 20 to 30, baritones 20 to 32 and basses 20 to 33.
