

JDL ON WAY OUT -- GOOD

NEW YORK (WNS) --Several thousand leaders and members of New-England Chapters of the Jewish Defense League have resigned from JDL because of dissatisfaction with its "militant" tactics and formed a new organization, "The Jewish Survival Legion".

Allan Mallenbaum, one of the founders of JSL and a former administrative director of the JDL, said JSL was "dedicated to solving many of the problems JDL is attacking" but "within the framework of the law." He disclosed that JSL chapters had already been established in Boston and Worcester, Mass., Providence and Pawtucket, R.I. and Hartford, Conn.

NEW YORK (WNS) --Rabbi Meir Kahane, national chairman of

the Jewish Defense League, announced that his organization will conduct a consumer boycott against American companies doing business with the Soviet Union and will conduct "non-violent actions" against organizations engaged in cultural exchange programs with the USSR.

Earlier, Rabbi Kahane had announced an "indefinite moratorium" on harassment of Soviet officials and their families because "contacts" in the government and American Jewish organizations had assured him "JDL had made its point," he said.

The call for an "indefinite moratorium" followed by a day the indictment of Rabbi Kahane and eight members of the JDL on various charges of harassment, disorderly conduct and inciting

riot. All the defendants pleaded not guilty and were released on bail.

Avrum and Nancy Hershkovits, the couple arrested on Sept. 27 for attempting to board a London-bound airliner armed with guns and grenades, pleaded guilty to charges of falsifying their passports. They will be sentenced next month.

NEW YORK -- Commenting on the announcement by Rabbi Meir Kahane that he will no longer engage in violent tactics, the American Jewish Congress said, in a statement issued by Will Maslow, executive director:

"The reckless and irresponsible tactics of Rabbi Kahane and his small band of followers have been anti-Jewish, anti-democratic and counter-productive.

"We would like to believe that Rabbi Kahane has at long last

recognized that violence and harassment do not serve the cause of Soviet Jewry but rather harm it.

"It would be gratifying to think that Rabbi Kahane now concedes that bombing Soviet offices and calling Russian housewives dirty names as they shop in supermarkets will not change the Kremlin's policy toward Soviet Jewry. Only an aroused world conscience can do that -- and only if our actions are both militant and non-violent will we continue to win sympathy and support for the courageous Jews of the Soviet Union.

"The strategy of violence and terror contradicts everything that is noble in the Jewish tradition. Taking the law into one's own hands threatens the very rule of law on which a free society depends. And the harassment of Soviet personnel wins sympathy for the Kremlin,

IS RIGA TRIAL OF 4 JEWS ON?

NEW YORK (WNS) --Reports reaching here say the long scheduled trial of four Soviet Jews in Riga, Latvia has begun in total secrecy. Jewish sources in the Soviet Union could neither confirm or deny the reports.

If the reports are true, it is believed the trial is being conducted in a complete news blackout in an attempt by Soviet authorities to forestall the kind of protest that erupted last month against the Leningrad trial.

The four Jews re-

portedly on trial, charged with anti-Soviet activities, are Ruth Aleksandrovich, 23, a nurse; Arkady Shpilberg, 23, an engineer, and Mikhail Shpshelovich, 27 and Boris Maftsier, 23, occupations unknown.

It was reported that Margarita Shpilberg, the wife of Arkady Shpilberg, has given birth to a daughter and has been attempting, unsuccessfully, to secure permission to see her husband and show him their child, a daughter named Yocheved.
