Those favorite sons of Father Time, the incomparable Mills Brothers, Thursday opened a four-week engagement in the Flamingo Hotel Casino Theatre, headlining a star-spangled dust-to-dawn entertainment bill.

Appearing with the Mills Brothers in the Casino Theatre are comedian Jackie Gayle, Glenn Smith & The Fables and ex-Checkmate Sonny Charles, who is making his first Las Vegas appearance as a single.

The Mills Brothers continue to maintain their status as superstars, a ranking that now dates back more than 40 years. The incredible trio has managed to withstand every musical trend, from bebop through acid rock. Their sound today is just as melodious as it was when they were just getting started in the business.

The brothers have always been top-selling recording artists and are constantly deluged with requests for

oldies like "Opus One", "Up a Lazy River" and "Paper Doll" as well as for newer hits like "Cab Driver", "Walking Maggie Home" and "Between Winston-Salem and Nashville".
