

### JEWISH NEWS BRIEFS

LONDON (WNS)--The fate of five Jews, arrested in connection with last summer's alleged hijacking plot, but not placed on trial in Leningrad last December, remains a mystery.

MONTREAL (WNS)--Nazi-hunter Simon Wiesenthal has charged a 59-year-old Vancouver janitor, Ivan Dimitrovich Chrobotyn, of personally directing the machine-gun killing of 300 Jews while serving as chief of the Ukrainian auxiliary police during World War II.

JERUSALEM (WNS)--David Rockefeller, chairman of the Chase Manhattan Bank, said he had found a greater desire for peace and more willingness to come up with "constructive and flexible proposals" today in Cairo, Beirut and Amman than anytime during the past seven years.

BUCHAREST (WNS)--A memorial service was held in the Choral Synagogue to mark the 30th anniversary of the 1941 pogrom that killed 120 Jews in this city.

WASHINGTON (WNS)--In a letter which appears in the current issue of the newsletter Near East Report, Joseph J. Sisco, Assistant Secretary of State for Near East and South Asia Affairs, denied that the U.S. was pressuring Israel to withdraw to her pre-war 1967 borders.

NEW YORK (WNS)--The Jewish Association for College Youth, a newly established independent organization funded by the Federation of Jewish Philanthropies, has announced grants of \$12,500 have been made to Jewish student groups at Columbia University and New York University, the Jewish Student Press Service, the New York Union of Jewish Students and the editorial-board of a citywide Jewish student newspaper.

JERUSALEM (WNS) -- Defense Minister Moshe Dayan advised the Knesset that more than 30 Arab families from the Gaza Strip who are related to wanted terrorists, have been exiled to a deserted town in the Sinai to prevent them from supplying the terrorists with money and food.

JERUSALEM (WNS)--Absorption Minister Nathan Peled told the Knesset that 10,000 Soviet Jews have applied for exit visas and said that the total number of Russian Jews who want to come to Israel was believed to be in the tens of thousands if not hundreds of thousands.

NEW YORK--The American Jewish Committee has published a 20-page annotated bibliography on Negro-Jewish relations representing varying viewpoints on the changing relationship between the two groups.
