NEW YORK--The seventh annual Salute To Israel parade will be held on Sunday, April 25, 1971, marking Israel's 23rd year of state-hood. The theme is "Am Yisrael Chai" (The People of Israel Live). The parade will take place from 11:00 A.M. to 2:30 P.M. and will be routed along 5th Avenue, New York City, from 57th to 86th Streets.

NEW YORK--More than 7,000 people will attend the two performances of the 20th Annual Israel Dance Festival on Sunday, March 28, 1971 at Madison Square Garden's Felt Forum in New York. Members of the Israel Delegation to the United Nations, the Israel Consulate General, as well as leaders of the major American Jewish organizations will be in the audience.


