Jewish population left in that communist puppet state, was responsible for instigating the uneasy situation. At the same time, reports out of West Berlin almost casually indicate that there is a growth in the neo-Nazi party. Anti-Semitism, a disease which has plagued humanity for generations, is still a long way from being cured. It continues to fester and show its ugliness.

Polish communist bosses have been "kind enough" to offer to allow Jews to emigrate to Israel, but the red-controlled press continues to

stir hatred by blaming Jewish University students for the demonstrations and disturbances. Warsaw Radio condemned these students for being happy about "Israel's aggression against the peace loving Arab people." This type of false accusation is not new.

History reveals how many times "the big lie" has been employed. It is a routine which anti-semites use frequently to nourish their hatreds. In the past the world stood by and watched "the impossible" happen. The vital question is now: What will the free world do about these new signs of the di-

sease? Has the world forgotten the dreaded pogroms of yesteryear? Will the atrocities perpetrated by Nazi Germany be overlooked? Will the world allow the rebirth of anti-semitism in Poland and Germany and shrug it off as only "an incident"?

Reactions from Jewish communities everywhere to the events in Poland, have been direct and positive. The flagrant lies emanating from Warsaw have been publicly condemned by leading national organizations in the United States and Canada. Communism's latest effort to stir hatred of the Jewish people has not gone unnoticed this time. And a keen eye is being kept as well on the activities of the neo-nazis in Germany.

In this season of Passover, it would be appropriate that each one of us rededicate himself to strengthening Jewry throughout the world. Let this magnificent Jewish festival remind us that liberty never did come easily, and that freedom must be watched carefully at all times. And we must see to it that we teach these facts "diligently unto our children". They must know the real meaning of the soul-stirring words related to Passover, namely, the exodus from Egypt which took our forebears "from slavery to freedom, from darkness to light."

In this generation, and from this day forward, we must stand shoulder to shoulder with our Jewish brethren wherever they may be. We must not let them down. The Jewish people will be keeping a watchful eye on events throughout the world as they occur. Anti-Semitism will be fought and eradicated wherever it may show itself. The story of Passover will always remind us of our precious liberty, and the fact that our vigil to keep it safe must be eternal.

Like freedom loving

people everywhere, American Jews continue to hope and pray that in our lifetime we will yet see peace for all humanity. It is a way of life in our tradition. Let us hope that it will very soon become a way of life for everyone.

I take this opportunity, in behalf of my wife and family, to wish all of you a happy Passover season. I hope that you, your family and friends will celebrate the holiday joyously, and that in the very near future, we will together celebrate peace throughout the world.
