RABBI OFFICIATES AT SON'S WEDDING

Rabbi Moses J. Feldman--who has performed numberless weddings in and around Los Angeles since he arrived in the City of Angels from London in 1920-- officiated in grand style at the wedding of his career. He tied the nuptial knot of his son, Rabbi David Michael Feldman, on the latter's own synagogal platform in Brooklyn, New York.

The charming bride, Avivah Joy Bornstein, Cambridge-born and London-bred, is a former Day School teacher in London. She is the daughter of Mrs. Maurice Cohen and the late Rev. Harry Bornstein, who was a Chaplain in the Armed Forces.

Over 700 guests--including Catholic Priests, State Senators and Councilmen--attended the unique and colorful ceremony at the Bay Ridge Jewish Center, where the bridegroom has been spiritual leader since 1960.

The bridegroom's sister, Goldie D. Fendel, assisted their father in escorting the bridegroom to the pulpit. His brother-in-law, Rabbi Meyer Fendel, Dean of the Nassau Hebrew Academy, recited one of the wedding blessings, as did the bride's stepfather, Maurice Cohen.

The bridegroom, Dr. David Feldman, an authority on marital affairs, was recently appointed Consultant to

the President's Commission on Population Growth and the Future of America. The Commission will recommend population policy for the United States Government.

One of nine children--Dr. Feldman is well known as the author of "Birth Control in Jewish Law," published by New York University Press. The book, subtitled "Marital Relations, Contraceptions, and Abortion, as set forth in the Classic Texts of Jewish Law," is now in its second printing. Dr. Feldman was invited to Rome to address a conference on the subject of his book, and delivered a series of guest lectures at the Law School of the Hebrew University of Jerusalem.

He is also invited in the local area to lecture on the subject of his book.

Traditional festivities honoring the bride and groom continued throughout the week, beginning with "Sheva Brochos" at the Fendel home in West Hempstead, Long Island.

The couple flew to London for a full-scale wedding reception given by the bride's parents. From London, the newlyweds will fly to Jerusalem for another reception to be tendered by the Rabbinical Assembly of America, now meeting in the Holy City.

The bridegroom, Rabbi Feldman, is a brother to our White House correspondent, Trude B. Feldman.

TEL AVIV (WNS)--Nahal Katora, a paramilitary settlement, was established in the Arava region of the Negev, 20 miles north of Eilat and less than two miles west of the Jordanian border. The settlement will grow early winter vegetables.

LONDON (WNS)--The Institute for Strategic Studies, in its annual report for 1970, states that Egypt received more military aid from the Soviet Union than any other non-communist country. The Institute reported Egypt received \$2.5 billion in military aid in 1970 and, since 1967, had received \$4.5 billion in financial aid.

JERUSALEM (WNS)--Housing Minister Zeev Sharef, told the Knesset that 2,600 Jewish housing units will be built in the former Arab sector of East Jerusalem.

JERUSALEM (WNS)--Officials of the Transport Ministry announced that drivers' licenses will be denied to drug addicts and the license of any person convicted of a drug offense will be revoked. The license will be restored only if the person proves that he has been cured of the drug habit, officials said.

ROME (WNS)--Rome's Jewish community has protested the proposal to pardon Herbert Kappler, a former SS officer who was sentenced to serve a life prison term for his part in the Ardeatine Caves massacre of 1944 in which 330 persons, including 80 Jews, were murdered by the Nazis.

DETROIT (WNS)--Bayard Rustin, executive director of the A. Philip Randolph Institute, was the recipient of the fourth annual John F. Kennedy Award of The National Council of Jewish Women.

NEW YORK--Clarence E. Unterberg, prominent philanthropic and civic leader, has been named recipient of the 1971 Herbert H. Lehman Human Relations Award, it was announced by Philip E. Hoffman, President of the AMERICAN JEWISH COMMITTEE, which presents the annual award.
