It didn't peace" The moment German troops goosestepped into Poland, it was a declaration of war, Churchill solemnly informed the world. Japan sneak-attacked Pearl Harbor without the slightest warning.

There is no such thing as war being in-evitable. War takes place only when leaders of aggressive nations find it to their advantage. Smart nations these days do not allow themselves to get into a war unless it is the precise time and place they planned to get involved. When that time comes, reason, logic, understanding, willingness to compromise, all play

no part.

Analyzing what is taking place in the Middle East right now, whether there will be a war

or not, we first must determine what Russia will do. That is the main problem.

One thing is certain. War will take place only if and when Russia so desires. Nothing on earth will force the Soviet Union into a war against her will, and no force in the world will prevent a war Russia wants. Keep in mind this apparent philosophy of modern warfare. It is useless to spend time, energy and anxiety on each act that transpires. It all depends on whether Russia is ready or not.

The Communists weren't ready in June of 1957, although it cost them a billion in aid to the Arabs. Even the closure of the Suez Canal wasn't enough to bring them into the war. Why? They just weren't ready for the war at that moment.

There were other moments when the world held its breath. The U.S. blockade of Cuba, the invasions by North Korea and North Viet Nam, when the U.S. intervened, and others. Russia sent money, supplies, advisers, all kinds of propaganda, but kept its army intact.

Right now Israel is the pawn in the game of Russian chess and unfortunately the Soviets
