The classical Horatio Alger hero had it easy compared to Mr. Hack, who came here from Poland at the age of 16, with \$3 to his name. He learned English while selling newspapers, did stints in repairing umbrellas, selling carpets and farming chickens.

In Detroit, where he went to live, both he and his wife chanced to have poor feet. This led to an incredible career which made this autodidact one of the world's most illustrious inventors.

His own ailment led Nathan Hack to study the physiology of the foot, which led him to design improved shoes, which led him to the remedial shoe business, which led to a series of inventions which have brought relief to thousands of disabled people all over the world.

The Hack walker has emancipated many wounded veterans from wheelchairs and enabled them to move about. The Hack-O-Maker introduced a new method of foot measurement. Hack's "ripple-soled shoes" have been a blessing to many who suffer from sore feet.

Acclaimed by inventors' association, periodicals, doctors and gratified patients by the thousands, Mr. Hack recently received an accolade from Temple Beth Shalom, of Santa Monica, for his loyalty to Judaism. Hurrah!

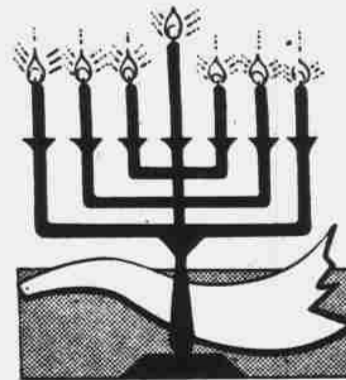
