What also matters is our response to trouble. The way we react today, will determine the lives and the future hopes of millions of our people. The words committment, involvement, participation, are not new words ... even though the younger generation thinks they wrote them into the dictionary. They belong to us too. They've always belonged to us. We are truly a family. This we've really learned over the past 25 years. And, like the popular cigarette commercial says... 'We've come a long way'... 25 years ago scarcely a finger was lifted to save 6 million Jews from death ... but just a few months ago the entire civilized world clamored to save the lives of just 2 Jews in Russia. Yes...we do have friends around the world ... but the world looks to us first to lead the way in caring and in doing. And, if we don't care and take the lead in doing, then who will?

Yes, it is true, Jews are people who hold hands around the world. And as long as they need us, we will hold their hands tightly in ours."
