

JEWISH NEWS BRIEFS

TEL AVIV (WNS)--Six thousand electric power station workers went on strike in an attempt to force the government to rescind its ban on a wage agreement it had reached with the State-run Israel Electric Corp.

TEL AVIV (WNS)--Maj. Gen. Shlomo Goren has resigned as chief chaplain of Israel's armed forces, a position he has held for the past 23 years. He has become Chief Rabbi of Tel Aviv and president of its rabbinical court.

NEW YORK (WNS)--Rabbi Israel Dresner, president of the New Jersey Association of Reform Rabbis, said "The Orthodox monopoly of Judaism in Israel is hurting the Jewish faith."

MONTREAL (WNS)--One hundred Canadian Jews have raised \$1 million in little more than three months in order to adopt a young Israeli settlement in the Arava, it was announced at the annual meeting of the Jewish National Fund of Canada.

JERUSALEM (WNS)--Premier Golda Meir warned that "Israel will take all measures to safeguard free civilian navigation" in international waters. The statement was issued after a cabinet meeting following a bazooka attack on a Liberian Tanker under charter by an Israeli firm in the Straits on Babel-Mandab.

TEL AVIV (WNS)--Gen Yeshayahu Gavish of the Army Reserves said that the "gap" in military capabilities between Israel and Egypt has widened since the Six-Day War even though the Egyptian Army has improved under Russian tutelage. Speaking on Kol Israel radio he said the "Weight of Russian weaponry" not the "ability of Egypt's army" is of greatest concern to Israel.

MINNEAPOLIS (WNS)--At the suggestion of the Jewish Community Relations Council of Minnesota, the State Legislature had passed a law permitting public employes to observe all religious holidays.

NEW YORK--The proportion of Frenchmen holding anti-Semitic attitudes has remained relatively static during the past five years even though relations between France and Israel have become strained and the late President Charles de Gaulle made statements widely considered anti-Semitic, according to the findings of an opinion poll on French attitudes toward Jews reported by the American Jewish Committee.

BROOKLYN -- More than 600 persons at a public meeting in Congregation Shaare Torah of Flatbush called on the Nixon Administration to counter a new Soviet threat in the Middle East by promptly granting "Israel's urgent requests for planes and other arms to deter any aggressive notions that may be entertained in Cairo and Moscow."

NEW YORK--A group of outstanding communal leaders, businessmen, rabbis, and professors from all over the United States have been elected to the Board of Trustees of the American Zionist Youth Foundation, it was announced here by Dr. Arnulf M. Pins, Chairman of the Board of Trustees of the AZYF.

WALTHAM, MASS--A major bequest to Brandeis University of more than \$400,000 from the estate of Mary Hirschfield of Chestnut Hill, Mass., has established graduate fellowships in the humanities.

NEW YORK--A Socio-Medical Center has been opened in Bucharest to provide medical care and social services either at the Center or at home for needy and aged handicapped Jews, it was announced last week by Samuel L. Haber, Executive Vice-Chairman of the Joint Distribution Committee.

NEW YORK--Democratic Senator John O. Pastore of Rhode Island and Republican Representative John H. Buchanan, Jr., Alabama, will co-chair the Congressional Committee for National Bible Week, November 21-28, 1971, it was announced today by Justice Arthur J. Goldberg, National Chairman.
