WASHINGTON (WNS) Georgetown University --State Department spokesmen agreed with Senator Henry M. Jackson (Dem., Wash.) that the Arab states outnumbered Israel six to one in jet aircraft, but maintained that the pilot-to-aircraft ratio 'sharply favors' lsrael. They said Egypt had more planes but not enough trained pilots to fly them.
