Just a bunch of escapees from the concentration camps of Nazi Germany, Spain, Eastern Europe, Russia, Yemen, Morocco and other countries where they were enslaved, beaten and tortured.

"How dare such people rise up and retaliate merely because their men, women and children are being killed daily by marauding infiltrators who cut off the ears of their victims to bring back proof to the paymasters that another Israeli has been murdered?"

"Eisenhower, Dulles, Nasser, Bulganin, Khrushchev and the rest of the newly-created allies will teach Israel a lesson. But all is not lost. Some good has even come from the evil which Israel created in the world.

"We have finally won Russia over to our side. Of course, England and France are now against us, but what does that matter as long as the Communists agree that we are doing the right thing.

I wonder whether the United States will return the Russian compliment and introduce a resolution in the United Nations condemning the attack on a Russian tank which was made by a 14-year-old Hungarian girl who hurled a jar of flaming gasoline and set fire to a tank of the Communists which was on a peaceful mission of attempting to restore order in Hungary.

"The dead body of the little girl lies in the streets of Budapest, covered by a Hungarian flag, while the Russian tank smolders beside her.

"Russia and the United States stand together against Israel.

"No longer will it be necessary for Eisenhower to send 'strong language' notes to Bulganin rejecting his offer to consult on methods for stopping the testing of super hydrogen bombs.

"Bulganin will never again be accused by Eisenhower of meddling in the internal politics of the United States, because the hydrogen bomb is merely an internal affair of this country and does not affect the world in any way.

"The Eisenhower foreign policy has been proved correct. He has refused to send aid to Israel. The tanks we sent to Saudi Arabia, the economic aid to Egypt, and the jet planes and Stalin tanks given to Egypt by Russia can never be used against us because the Israelis have none of this equipment.

"All this small nation has is moral and spiritual strength, and surely this is not enough to combat hydrogen bombs and atomic missiles which are now in the control of the United States and Russia.

"Russia and the United States standing together against America's traditional allies -- Great Britain and France. Britain used her veto in the United Nations for the first time in history and France for only the second, and it had to be against a resolution of the United States. But England and France stood alone.

"Not only Russia but Nationalist China, Iran and Yugoslavia voted with the United States. "What strange bedfellows a little oil can make!

"A country, like an individual, is judged by the company it keeps. With the whole of Europe now embroiled against Russia. With little countries in rebellion against Communist tyranny -- small nations yearning to be free and risking lives and shedding blood in pursuit of freedom from enslavement by Russia -- suddenly we find ourselves on the same side as the Communists.

"And just as suddenly we are thrust by the Eisenhower administration against England, France and all the free nations of the world.

"We have suddenly become allies with the bloodletters of Europe.

"This is a real fallout, and much more dirty than the radioactive fallout of the H-bombs. This is a fallout inspired by a supposed leader of the free world -- the President of the greatest democratic nation on the face of the earth." (1956)

AJC STAND ON RELIGIOUS SCHOOLS

NEW YORK--A leading Reform rabbi defended the American Jewish Congress against charges by two Orthodox rabbis that the Congress, in its opposition to government support of religious schools, was bent on subverting Jewish education.

In a statement released to the New York TIMES, Rabbi Edward Klein, spiritual leader of the Stephen Wise Free Synagogue in Manhattan and a member of the Social Action Commission of the Central Conference of American Rabbis and the Union of American Hebrew Congregations, declared:

"I strongly deplore the Orthodox rabbis' attack on the American Jewish Congress. The Congress, since its inception, has zealously and sacrificially served the Jewish people here and abroad and sought to implement in the general community the democratic ideals of justice and freedom which spring from Scripture.

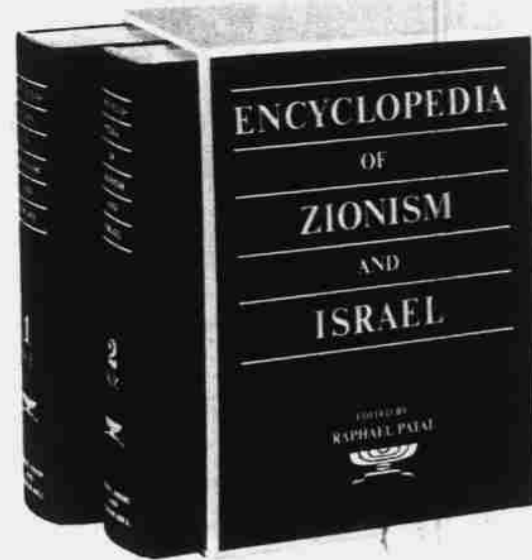
"It is this that has motivated the Congress as well as other national Jewish bodies to oppose public aid to sectarian schools.

"While cognizant of the important role of parochial and day schools in American education, we insist that such schools must derive their support from the sectarian bodies which conduct them. Otherwise we breach the wall of separation between church and state which has enabled American democracy to flourish free of restraints and religion in America.

"The public schools are a bulwark of American democracy; support of sectarian education out of public funds would divert essential aid from our public schools, which are now in dire financial straits, and lead to the proliferation of private schools and further divisiveness in our society."

Rabbi Klein, who is visiting lecturer in homiletics at the Hebrew Union College-Jewish Institute of Religion, is a member of the Metropolitan Council of the American Jewish Congress.

His statement was in response to a report in the Sunday New York TIMES July 18 quoting Rabbi Bernard Berzon, president of the Rabbinical Council of America, as accusing the Congress of improperly using Jewish communal funds
