APARTMENT HOUSING FOR ARABS

TEL AVIV (WNS) -- Officials here said the transfer of Arab refugees from the Nuizerat camp, largest refugee camp in the Gaza Strip, to 1,000 empty apartments in El Arish in the northern Sinai, will continue. The "thinning out" of refugees in the camp has been ordered for security purposes and is not part of a general solution of the Gaza refugee problem, Gen. Shlomo Gazit, the officer in charge of coordination of activities in the occupied areas said.

MIDEAST PIPELINE

LONDON(WNS)-- Eight West European nations -- France, West Germany, Italy, Britain, Spain, Holland, Belgium and Greece--have contracted to build a 42-inch oil pipeline system connecting the Suez to the Mediterranean. Work on the 209 mile system will take two to three years and will cost an estimated \$280 million.
