ISRAEL REJECTS SISCO PLAN TO REOPEN CANAL

mediately after the conclusion of the services.

BUTCHER OF LYON

PARIS (WNS) -- An agreement between West Germany and France, requiring automatic new trials in West German courts for all Nazis condemned in France in absentia was feared imperiled today by a ruling by the Munich prosecutor ending all prosecution of Klaus Barbie, wartime head of the Gestapo in Lyon.

Barbie, known as the "butcher of Lyon" for his atrocities, was

condemned in absentia to death by a French military court on Nov. 25, 1954.

But Barbie fled to South America and reportedly is still hiding there. The Association of Nazi Victims filed a complaint with West German authorities, who responded by opening an investigation of the case. But the prosecutor, M. Rabl, ruled today a "discontinuation" in the probe, holding there was insufficient proof.

JERUSALEM (WNS)-- The Cabinet has unanimously supported Premier Golda Meir's rejection of the Sisco plan to reach an interim agreement to reopen the Suez Canal. The plan called for Egyptian troops to occupy the East Bank territory evacuated by Israeli troops.

Israel Galili, Minister Without Portfolio, in a radio interview said that the canal reopening did not appear to be a "practical proposition at this time" but added that it might, in time, become the basis for negotiations.

Gen. Yitzhak Rabin, Ambassador to the U.S., who was expected to assume a cabinet posi-

tion, had his term as Ambassador extended because of the continuing negotiations for an interim agreement. Before returning to his Washington post, Rabin told newsmen that the U. S. had "no fixed position" on conditions for an interim agreement. He said that if the U.S. had taken such position, she would have made the same mistake made by Dr. Gunnar V. Jarring, UN Mideast negotiation who, "by issuing a document making a position on the Middle East issues" had made himself a "partner in the dispute" and unable to serve as a mediator unless he withdraws the document.

SENATORS URGE ISRAELI SUPPORT

WASHINGTON (WNS) -- Ten members of the 17 member Senate Foreign Relations Committee urged Secretary of State William P. Rogers to grant Israel's request for \$200 million in supporting assistance to enable her to meet her "urgent defense requirements."

With their letter they

sent a copy of the report of the House Committee on Foreign Affairs which makes provisions for Israel's request.

The Senator's letter noted that meeting Israel's request was a "vital corollary to maintaining a balance of defense capability in the Middle East."

Pity Paul Price

We feel sorry for Paul Price.

He does not deserve our sympathy because he is an outrageous liar, a despicable despoiler of decent journalism standards, and a very, very stupid man. We'll explain each of these appendages one at a time.

For years we've been criticizing Paul for his wanton disregard of American justice by trying a case in his column before it comes to trial. He knows as well as anyone that a person arrested and charged is considered innocent until proven guilty.

But Price continually ignores this fundamental guarantee. Each of his subjects is in unhappy, very serious circumstances, when this "big, bold, fearless" phoney writer spouts his venom. The unfortunate victim of Paul's "poison pen" is usually in jail, without opportunity or even desire to respond. That's when Price is best at rabble rousing public sentiment.

When members of the cast of "Hair" were arrested, Paul hastened to get in his licks, calling them every low name in the books, convicting them, sentencing them and jailing them before the trial. When the charges against them were dismissed, nary a peep out of Paul. His indecent publisher allowed Price to get off without a retraction. The only beef was our small voice.

Recently, a father was charged with murdering an infant child. It was a horrible circumstance. Was it necessary for Paul to write a "bleeding heart" column, commencing and ending with a baby jingle, calling the unfortunate, miserable parent every low epithet in his writing vocabulary. It is a shame this horrible event took place, but it could have happened in any community. Isn't it enough the public has to suffer through this kind of trial as it will unfold in court? We all desire to have justice prevail. Is advance prejudice necessary? Paul Price thinks so. His column was revolting, and 100% un-American.

Now comes Price with a libel suit against our son Jay, publisher of the Las Vegas Free Press. The suit also names City Commissioner Hal Morelli and his campaign manager Bill Willard. Price, who was a favorite going in, lost the election to Morelli by 2,000 votes. Price, (in his column) said he seriously believes he was libeled. It certainly was his prerogative to elect to institute the suit. What is more, if Paul's contention is correct, he deserves to win. Is this a fair appraisal by us, so far?

But you could bet dollars to doughnuts, Paul would not let it rest at that stage. His very first column, after filing suit, was an abortive attempt to prove his case in the newspaper. This, of course, opens the door for us to retaliate, except we would never sink to his low level. We will be content to allow the courts to determine who is right or wrong.

Now we come to the portion where we charge Price with being a liar. The definition of a liar is a person who knowingly spreads false-
