TEL AVIV (WNS)--Meir Shamir, outgoing director of the Jewish Agency's Hill Settlement Department, predicted that within the next seven years, the Israel population of the Golan Heights will be between 15-20,000. He will be succeeded in the Agency post by Yaacov Arad.

JERUSALEM (WNS) -- Foreign Minister Abba Eban reportedly expressed astonishment at the U.S. State Department's criticism of Defense Minister Moshe Dayan's speech last Thursday in which he told an army graduation ceremony that Israel should act as a permanent govern-ment in the administered Arab territories.

TEL'AVIV (WNS) -- An Israel tribunal imposed a sentence of eight years on Edith Burghalter, 60, and four years on her 69-yearold husband, Pierce, who were found guilty of having been in the service of a terrorist group and with possession of sabotage devices.

NEW YORK (WNS) -- George Bush, United States Ambassador to the United Nations, has asked U.N. Secretary General U Thant to help who was head of the fabled "Red Orchestra," the anti-Nazi Soviet espionage ring which operated in France and Belgium during World War II.

NEW YORK -- Ten new Jewish military chaplains are entering the U.S. Armed Forces in time to plan and conduct Rosh Hashanah (Jewish New Year) services for Jewish military personnel, it was announced by Rabbi Edward T. Sandrow, chairman of the National Jewish Welfare Board Commission on Jewish Chaplaincy and spiritual leader of Temple Beth El, Cedarhurst, N.Y. Rosh Hashanah begins at sundown September 19.
