

ARAB FEDERATION HARMFUL THREAT

WASHINGTON (WNS) --The recent no-peace, no-negotiations stance adopted by the heads of Egypt, Syria and Libya in an Arab Federation unity statement was labeled "harmful...unfortunate" and "inconsistent with Security Council Resolution 242" by State Department spokesman Robert J. McClosky.

The Arab leaders decided that there would be "no yielding an inch of Arab territory, no bargaining on the Palestinian cause," McClosky's comment: "It is difficult to see how the

parties can move toward a peace settlement if they talk only about what cannot be accepted." But Administration experts are puzzled by the statement and uncertain whether it was rhetoric designed for local consumption or agreement by the Arabs on a firm policy.

The statement "disturbed" the State Department "very much since it came from heads of governments." A followup effort will be made "in due course," McClosky said. Meanwhile, Israel's Ambassador to the United States called on the President of the Security Council to discuss the situation

created by the Federation statement.

TEL AVIV (WNS)--Reliable Israeli sources see the new Arab Federation of Egypt, Libya and Syria as a potential threat to Israel if Libya purchased Mirage jets become operational from Egyptian or Syrian airfields. They note that the Federation will have a united training-and-operations com-

mand for deployment of the services and equipment of any of the three partners.

Moreover, they point out, since Libya has a token unit at the Suez Canal front, Libyan planes could be deployed there. But "le Monde" quoted "competent French sources" in justification of the French decision to continue deliveries of the planes:

JORDAN SUPPORTS CEASE FIRE

JERUSALEM (WNS)--Jordanian King Hussein told a Beirut daily newspaper that the cease-fire with Israel should be maintained because another war would only mean more "catastrophies" and further losses of land. Political observers here interpret this statement to mean that he would maintain it even if Egypt orders a renewal of warfare with Israel. He declared

that continued Arab pressure on his government against his Palestinian guerrillas campaign "will neither affect us nor will they make us change our policy."

GOOD LT. GOV. STAYS ON

Lieutenant Governor Harry Reid quelled speculation he would be a candidate in the 1972 Congressional election.

The oft mentioned candidate announced, "At this time, after much deliberation, I have decided not to enter the upcoming Congressional election."

Reid said the announcement was made with regard to the work and organization already begun by many individuals and groups who asked him to enter the race. "I've received many letters, phone calls, and have been approached by some pretty powerful groups encouraging me to enter the race."

"Their encouragement and belief has been gratifying, as has the high chances given me by statewide press, but I must, at this time, decline the honor."

The lieutenant governor based his decision on a number of reasons. "One, if I decided to run, everything I did this next year would be questioned --as being politically motivated. I don't want that, Nevada doesn't need it."

"Also," he continued, "there are problems in Nevada that need attention, such as the state's economy and utilities and pollution, to name only three."

Reid, one of the state's most active lieutenant governors, revealed work on specific projects for the governor that are of lasting importance to the state, not just a pitch to gain public acclaim at election time.

"I have a lot of confidence in Governor O'Callaghan," Reid said. "He is an outstanding governor likely the best Nevada has ever had. He is an honest and hardworking man and I feel I can be of service to him and Nevada."
