**RABBI DONATES \$75,000 TO HIS TEMPLE ON HIS 75TH BIRTHDAY**

Dr. Israel Goldstein, the world-renowned Jewish leader and Rabbi Emeritus of Congregation B'nai Jeshurun, the mother of Conservative synagogues in the nation and the second oldest in New York City, will mark his 75th birthday by presenting a gift instead of receiving one.

His "birthday gift" to the Congregation which he served as Rabbi for 42 years from 1918 to 1960, will be a \$75,000 Religious School Scholarship Fund which he personally raised among congregants and friends. The fund will provide 100 free scholarships annually in the B'nai Jeshurun afternoon religious school.

A Religious Service honoring Dr. Goldstein will be held in the Congregation's synagogue, noted for its resplendent Byzantine design, at 257 West 88th Street, on Saturday morning, September 25th at 9:00 o'clock, and will be followed by a small reception. At

that time, Dr. Goldstein will present the Scholarship Fund to Rabbi William Berkowitz, his successor in the pulpit, and to Charles H. Silver, Congregation president and a prominent figure in philanthropic and communal affairs. Cantor Robert H. Segal will chant the Sabbath music.

Dr. Goldstein's career, spanning a

period of 53 years, has encompassed a broad spectrum of activities, including the presidency of the major Jewish organizations in the United States, both of a religious and secular nature. As a committed Zionist, who played an influential role in the establishment of the State of Israel, he has made his home in Jerusalem

since his retirement from the Congregation at the end of 1960.

For the past decade, he has served as World Chairman of Keren Hayesod-United Israel Appeal, based in Jerusalem, which raises funds for Israel among two and a half million Jews in 69 countries, excluding the United States.
