## DEBATE ON JERUSALEM

### FREE PRESS OFFERS STOCK

Las Vegas Free Press, Inc., a Nevada corporation, is offering to the public 300,000 shares of its common stock at a price of \$1.50 per share (\$1.10 par value).

The company is in the business of publishing a tabloid newspaper.

The stock of Las Vegas Free Press, Inc. is being offered in accordance with the exemption from registration with the U.S. Securities and Exchange Commission under Regulation A of the Securities Act of 1933.

The 300,000 shares of common stock are offered to the public only by an Offering Circular.

### UNITED NATIONS

(WNS)--The long awaited Security Council debate on Jerusalem opened with Jordan's Ambassador to the UN, Baha Ud-Din Toukan charging that Israel has embarked on a campaign to "Judaize Arab Jerusalem." Charging that in all the history of the UN no other nation has ever "defied the authority of the UN and destroyed its reputation" as much or as long as Israel, the Ambassador stated "the only course left is for the Security Council to invoke whatever sanctions it deems fit to ensure respect for its decisions and to prevent a fait accompli in Jerusalem with interfering in a just solution which must

be ultimately reached."

In his reply, Israel's Ambassador Yosef Tekoah claimed that the real reason for Jordan's call for the current debate on Jerusalem was to divert attention from internal and inter-Arab problems with "a show of hostility towards the Jewish State." He noted that the most important building project undertaken in East Jerusalem since 1967 was the reconstruction of the Jewish Quarter which had been "destroyed by the Jordanians after they had occupied the Old City in 1948." Commenting on other Israeli activity on Mount Scopus, including the re-opening of branches of the Hebrew Univer-

### Public Backs Hughes 100%

Again, we point out, the only way to combat a corrupt newspaper like the Las Vegas Sun, is with an honest newspaper.

Sun publisher Hank Greenspun, a proven liar, is losing ground in his futile attempt to create economic chaos in the State of Nevada. His abortive, incessant attacks on Howard Hughes and the Hughes Tool Company executives who run the Nevada operations, have been dispelled, dissipated into thin air. But still he persists.

Having run out of specific accusations, not one of which has stood up, Greenspun now has commenced a campaign of vague generalities, so far-fetched, and so removed, they could generate only in the warped mind of either a blithering idiot, or a blinded, stumbling, vengeance-seeking publisher, who will go to any extreme. And there again, it may be a dying plunge in a crafty, premeditated plot to regain access to more millions he could bilk from billionaire Howard Hughes.

We have taken two superficial polls, 1) of the public image of Howard Hughes and 2) the credibility gap of his operations among his employees.

We find the general public almost 100% behind the man who has invested more than \$300,000,000 in Nevada. They cannot understand why there are so many obstacles in the path of one sixth of the state's gambling revenue. The man in the street does not understand exactly what is to be gained by denying licenses to accredited persons who seek to manage hotels and casinos currently in operation. Even those who are confused by the Sun's distorted headlines and outright lies in the editorials and Greenspun's column, are not hostile to H H. Some are indifferent, but all appear to desire the Hughes Nevada operations to be allowed to conduct its own business without harassment.

The general feeling is that any man who has amassed billions should be able to run off 300 million dollars in properties. And finally, if a man desires seclusion, he should be entitled to his own preference, especially if he is not interfering with the rights of others.

The second poll taken among the H H employees, while not conclusive because we had approached a minute fraction of the 8,000 involved, there appears to be 100% confidence in the present employers. These men and women are concerned with keeping their jobs, naturally. There appears to be some apprehension about the hassle over licenses and letters, but all are convinced the present bosses are determined to maintain efficiency and coordination in the operations. If anything, the Hughes employees seem to be more enthusiastic

### N. Y. C. NEGLECTS JEWISH POOR

NEW YORK (WNS) --The American Jewish Congress, the Association of Jewish Anti-Poverty Workers and Torah Umesorah have all charged the New York City Human Resources Administration with "outright discrimination" and falsifying reports dealing with charges of discrimination against Jewish poor in programs funded by the Office of Economic Opportunity. The charges were made though the HRA admitted the city's Jewish poor were "underserved by the city's anti-poverty agencies."

Dr. Alfred Schnell,

director of the Head Start Program for Torah Umesorah, said the program at the Yes-hiva Ahavas Yisroel, a Hassidic school in the Williamsburg section of Brooklyn, is being eliminated by the HRA and its Anti-Poverty Council. S. Elly Rosen, director of the Association of Jewish Anti-Poverty Workers, whose original charges of discrimination brought about investigations of the HRA by the OEO and a House Subcommittee on Labor and Education, which were critical of the discrimination of the city's anti-poverty programs, said his association would demand that 15 community corporations in the anti-poverty programs in areas with poor Jews appoint Jewish board members.

The AJCongress charged the HRA report with misrepresentation by implying that officials of public agencies who serve on the Council Against Poverty "represent a Jewish constituency when in fact they represent government agencies and all of the people served by those agencies--white, black, Jewish and non-Jewish."
