and more energetic in performing service to customers. This is reflected in the progressive improvement of business, especially at the Sands, which is now in the black.

The result of our poll is a direct refutation of the speculation made by Greenspun who stated without one iota of proof: "The past six months have produced a tragic blow to the public image of Howard R. Hughes. Of even greater significance is the development of a credibility gap in all of his operations, a gap of increasing proportions that now looms as a bottomless chasm."

This is what Greenspun has been attempting to create, but he has failed miserably.

The reason he has failed and will continue in the wallow of the mire he has created, is because the course of his actions do not make sense. What is he trying to prove?

Greenspun's character assassination of Hughes Tool Co. directors could lead only to chaos if he should be even slightly successful. But having lost in this phase of his onerous attempt to keep the HH Nevada operations from functioning smoothly, since the backgrounds and reputations of the directors have been cleared completely by the State Gambling Commission, he now turns to raising the question of whether the men named have actually been chosen by the billionaire, who prefers seclusion. Apparently the state authorities are at the same impasse.

The commission requested a hand-written, finger-printed letter of instruction. The first letter, typewritten, was not acceptable. A second letter, hand-written, was flown from the Bahamas to the commission chairman's office in Fallon. There was speculation whether it contained finger-prints.

Without any knowledge of the contents, at that time, the Sun headline blazed, Hughes Letter With Finger Prints, BUT WHOSE? Even before any information was known, the Sun was questioning the prints. This is nothing less than a stacked deck, with Greenspun dealing. It just happened that there were no fingerprints on the letter, which makes this purveyor of news nothing more than a purveyor of lies.

We asked an employee, high in the Hughes operation, why his company did not do something about the nefarious tactics of this notorious trouble monger. He answered, because the Hughes Tool directors are gentlemen. Therein lies the answer.

The vast difference between the Tool Co. directors and Greenspun is that they are gentlemen. We were told they could have him charged with a dozen criminal offenses. But up until now they look upon him as an annoyance, like a flea to be brushed from their shoulder. One never knows when a straw will break the camel's back. Then the boom will be lowered.

Let us compare the actions of HH with those of Greenspun during the past four years. The billionaire chose Nevada to invest more than \$300,000,000. He selected a man to manage these properties and to be properly licensed for the gambling operations. HH did not appear at the hearings. Instead Greenspun swore the man appointed was the one designated by Hughes. The law was relaxed to allow that man to be licensed.

Last November it was determined the man hired to run Hughes Nevada operations was unfit for the job. To substantiate this, nearly all of the operations were running in the red. Some of the properties were purchased from Greenspun at exorbitant prices. The man was fired.

Then it was disclosed that finders fees and kick-backs were rampant during the tenure of the fired man. Recently, after exhaustive study, it was found that mining claims costing \$18,000,000 were not worth \$100,000.

The Hughes Tool directors set about cleaning house, and they are doing a pretty good
