

JERUSALEM SHRINES ACCESSIBLE TO ALL: KEEP IT THAT WAY

NEW YORK (WNS) --Jewish lay and rabbinical leaders have charged "Important segments" of church leaders with applying a "blatant double standard" to the question of Jerusalem. They called for an urgent meeting with Catholic, Protestant and Moslem leaders to avoid a "rift" in interreligious relations. Rabbi Henry Siegman, executive vice-president of the Synagogue Council of America called Jeru-

salem "a perfect illustration of how the Christian theological bias makes hollow any insistence within Christian leadership that the Middle East situation is to be assessed on strictly political and moral grounds." He pointed out that the "wanton desecration of virtually every Jewish shrine" following the Jordanian occupation of East Jerusalem 19 years ago brought forth no outcry from Christians. But

now that control has reverted to Israel and the Shrines have become accessible to all faiths, "the Jewish presence is considered offensive." Phillip M. Kluznick, former American representative to the UN said "any effort made to force or sanctions to divide Jerusalem will undoubtedly be met by force." Rabbi Irving Lehrman, president of the Synagogue Council, said he had issued invitations to Christian and Moslem

leaders for fraternal discussions of "our respective associations with Jerusalem" which hopefully "will lead to a deeper and more respectful understanding of our respective involvement."
