

JEWISH NEWS BRIEFS

JERUSALEM (WNS)--Official sources here denied that Premier Golda Meir would meet with US President Richard M. Nixon, but confirmed that Mrs. Meir had sent a message to the President suggesting high-level consultations on renewed American shipments of planes and other military equipment.

JERUSALEM (WNS)--Japan has asked Israel to support a 10-nation proposal calling for a two-China solution to the problem of Chinese membership in the United Nations. In a taped radio interview, Foreign Minister Abba Eban said Israel would support seating Peking at the UN but had not yet decided how to vote on the Taiwan issue.

JERUSALEM (WNS)--The Cabinet rejected as "without justification" the Security Council resolution calling upon Israel to "halt" action that may change the status of East Jerusalem and urging Israel to "rescind all previous measures and actions" to alter the status of the city.

COPENHAGEN (WNS)--King Hussein said Jordan was "ready for a separate peace with Israel." He added that such a peace must be based on Security Council Resolution 242.

LOS ANGELES--Support of the pending measure to offer a U.S. haven to 30,000 Soviet Jews is gaining rapid momentum in the California Congressional delegation, the Pacific Southwest Regional offices of the Anti-Defamation League of B'nai B'rith and the Jewish Labor Committee jointly stated.

WASHINGTON--Israel's Foreign Minister Abba Eban will address the B'nai B'rith triennial convention that opens next Wednesday, Oct. 13, in Philadelphia.

CHICAGO--Senator Edmund S. Muskie called for increased military and economic support for Israel in a speech before the Weizmann Institute.

NEW YORK--Delegates to the twelfth annual national convention of Yavneh, the National Religious Jewish Students Association, blasted the Orthodox establishment for failing to adequately support campus activities for religious and nonreligious collegiates.

NEW YORK--Under an exchange program that enhances the Jewish programming of Jewish Community Centers and YM-YWHA's in the United States and Canada, 12 Israeli communal workers (shlichim) are joining the staffs of American Centers this fall for two or three-year periods of service.
