When you get a bit tired of the mass produced cuisine of strip hotels we have a suggestion. Take a look see at the Golden Steer restaurant just a block off the strip on west Sahara.

Hosted by amiable Joe Kludjian (of Four Fountains fame), the Golden Steer is an in-spot for all walks of Vegans. On any given evening you might see Shecky Greene, Dale Robertson or even Gov. Mike O'Callaghan dining in the peaceful harmony of an elegant and tasteful supper spot.

For an unusual appetizer you might order genuine diamond back rattlesnake, imported caviar or the conventional jumbo shrimp cocktail. When in season steamed clams or blue point oysters (by the half dozen) are ready and edible.

Your soup could include French onion au gratin or green turtle au sherry or even kangaroo tail at \$1.95. A generous salad helping of beef-steak tomatoes with pimientos and anchovies or hearts of romaine or even Golden Steer mixed greens, opens the gateway to a huge selection of delectable dinner treats.

Let us start with their seafood selections which include french fried jumbo shrimp, fresh brook trout, frog legs or abalone steak saute with lemon butter. You might be in the mood for a New York cut, pepper steak or a hajibaba steak, planked chopped sirloin or sauted chicken livers.

### US WITHHOLDING ISRAEL AID TO FORCE SUEZ SETTLEMENT

JERUSALEM (WNS) --Premier Golda Meir, in reply to newsmen's questions, charged that reaching an interim settlement to open the Suez Canal has been made "more difficult" by the General Assembly speech of U.S. Secretary of State William P. Rogers. Israeli sources view Rogers speech as a drift towards the Egyptian position and foresee a continued erosion of U. S.-Israeli relations.

Mrs. Meir made it clear that Rogers' speech and his subsequent talks with Foreign Minister Abba Eban was still under study, but her displeasure was obvious.

According to unofficial reports reaching here from Washington, Rogers told Eban that Israel's request for the resumption of Phantom jets deliveries on a two-a-month basis was still "under study." (Continued on Page 3)

### EBAN: TOTAL WITHDRAWAL, NEVER

MONTREAL (WNS)--President Anwar Sadat of Egypt was now ready to enter into a peace settlement with Israel provided that Egypt wrote its terms and Israel merely signed, Israel's Foreign Minister Abba Eban told a meeting sponsored by the Montreal Jewish Community Council. Nevertheless, he said, the outlook was better now than a year ago when Egypt adhered to the Khartoum formula of no recognition, no negotiations and no peace with Israel.

Speaking before an

audience of 4,500 in the Grand Ballroom of the Queen Elizabeth Hotel, while thousands more listened to his speech on the street, via loudspeakers, Eban repeated his five points for peace which he had outlined at the UN General Assembly Sept. 30, and said that if Egypt rejects each and every one of the points it will bear a heavy responsibility.

Stating that Israel's highest aim was peace, he added "partial withdrawal, yes, but total withdrawal, never."
