It is believed here the U.S. is withholding the jets and other military equipment to extract concessions from Israel on a Suez settlement.

Mrs. Meir differed with Rogers on three points -- the crossing of the Suez Canal, the duration of the cease-fire and guarantees that the terms of an interim settlement contain no commitment bearing on eventual overall peace settlement.

Israel is willing to withdraw her troops an unspecified distance from the Canal and permit a "symbolic" Canal crossing of 750 Egyptian troops.

Israel also objects to an interim agreement that calls for only a "limited cease-fire" and Mrs. Meir claims that based on Rogers' speech in the Assembly

The religious councils are appointed by the Religious Affairs Minister after consultation with the municipal councils and are meant to reflect the wishes of the religious community of each city.
