

U.S. WITHHOLDING

It is believed here the U.S. is withholding the jets and other military equipment to extract concessions from Israel on a Suez settlement.

Mrs. Meir differed with Rogers on three points--the crossing of the Suez Canal, the duration of the cease-fire and guarantees that the terms of an interim settlement contain no commitment bearing on an eventual overall peace settlement.

Israel is willing to withdraw her troops an unspecified distance from the Canal and permit a "symbolic" Canal crossing of 750 Egyptian troops.

Israel also objects to an interim agreement that calls for only a "limited cease-fire" and Mrs. Meir claims that based on Rogers' speech in the Assembly "Egypt's rulers can easily find support in his statements for their stubborn objection to the demand for an unlimited cease-fire." She added, "From the day the issue was raised, we stressed that the agreement for the opening of the Canal was not to be linked to any commitments regarding additional phases of withdrawal prior to peace. The demand for such advance commitments brought about the standstill of the Jarring talks."

EBAN FOR "MEDITERRANEAN COMMUNITY"

STRASSBOURG (WNS) --Israel's Foreign Minister Abba Eban, in an address to the Council of Europe General Assembly, called for the creation of "a Mediterranean community" which would include Israel, the Arab states and other nations bordering on that sea. The Council consists of the representatives of the parliaments of 17 West European countries.

Eban also urged that Israel be included in

the group of "developing countries to which the European Common Market is prepared to grant special tariff preferences."

He said unless Israel is granted the same customs rights, "our preferential agreement with the EEC would be effectively annulled."

CARTER NAMED TO TEL AVIV U.

NEW YORK (WNS) --Victor M. Carter, Los Angeles business-

man, civic leader and philanthropist was elected president of the American Friends of Tel Aviv University at a meeting here of the Board of Directors of the American Friends.

RELIGIOUS COUNCIL FOR JERUSALEM

JERUSALEM (WNS) --Protesting what he called the appointment without proper procedure of a new religious council for Jerusalem, Mayor Teddy Kollek

has called upon Justice Minister Yaacov Shimshon Shapiro to overrule the action of Dr. Zerach Warhaftig, Minister of Religious Affairs.

PAUCO OUT OF GOP

WASHINGTON (WNS) --Dr. Joseph Paucio, accused World War II Nazi collaborator, resigned as controller of the Heritage Groups Nationalities Council, a unit of the Republican Party's National Committee.

His resignation was rendered two days after his ouster was demanded by the Anti-Defamation League of B'nai B'rith who cited his record as an aide to Joseph Tiso, Hitler's puppet ruler of Slovakia, who was hanged as a war criminal after the war.

The choosing of a religious council is the first stage of the election of a new Chief Rabbinate, which is chosen by a panel of electors appointed by the religious councils (two-thirds of the panel) and by the municipal councils (one-third). The appointees must be citizens who respect religious tradition.

The religious councils are appointed by the Religious Affairs Minister after consultation with the municipal councils and are meant to reflect the wishes of the religious community of each city.

Kollek charged that the municipal council had not been consulted in the appointments and that the religious sector had not been properly heard.

If Kollek's protest is rejected, he can appeal to the High Court or ask for a committee of ministers to reconsider the case.
