**SOVIET PLANES TOO HIGH, SPEEDY FOR ISRAELI JETS**

JERUSALEM (WNS) --Two Soviet Foxbats, piloted by Soviet pilots, flew over Sinai at an altitude of 70,000 feet and a speed of 2.5 mach. Both altitude and speed are beyond the capabilities of Israel's Phantom jets. Within three minutes the Foxbats had penetrated 200 miles into the Sinai flying from a point west of El Arish on the Mediterranean to Ras Sudar on the Red Sea. Israeli interceptors failed to make contact with the Foxbats.

Defense Minister Moshe Dayan advised the Cabinet the overflight was "clearly intended" to impress upon both Israel and

Egypt that it is the Soviets who hold the real military power in the Middle East.

Military officials

said that if the Foxbats were ever used in combat against Israel they would be flown by Soviet pilots since it

was unlikely that Egyptians would be permitted to handle the jets in view of their poor performances in the slower, less sophisticated MIG-21s and MIG-17s.

**ISRAEL NO. 24 ON US AID LIST**

ATLANTIC CITY (WNS)--Sen. Stuart Symington (D., Mo.) refuted the Administration's contention that Israel has received "at least as much support" as any other nation and that the military balance of power in the Middle East was undisturbed despite continued Soviet arming of Egypt.

In an address to the 46th annual convention of Mizrachi Women, Symington said "in ranking the largest

recipients of U. S. overseas loans and grants -- military and economic -- Israel is not even among the first 20.

Israel is actually 24th on the list" which includes South Vietnam, South Korea, India, Pakistan and Taiwan.

"Despite the heavy military contributions to these other countries, the State of Israel has never received one cent of grant military assistance from the U.S.," Symington said.

**ISRAEL TO CURB ABUSES**

JERUSALEM (WNS) --Proposals to eliminate profiteering and other abuses of privileges by new immigrants have been approved by Absorption Minister Natan Peled.

The proposals call for stricter control of mortgages, loans and tax exemptions. An immigrant receiving a

low mortgage if forbidden to transfer it to another person without permission.

If he sub-leases his apartment or does not live in it for six months he will be required to pay the regular mortgage rates instead of the special low interest rate granted immigrants.
