OPERATION BRIDGE COMBATS DRUGS

Operation Bridge, a drug outreach counseling program, has opened its doors at 116 Hoover in Las Vegas to rap with youth of the Southern Nevada community who want to help drug abusers or who want to kick the habit themselves, according to Zel Lowman, President.

Dennis Jackson, highly experienced counselor formerly of Omaha, Nebraska, has been hired as director-counselor and has been working with about 75 other young people of the community in renovating the house and the property on Hoover as a headquarters. To assist him with the establishment of a 24-hour crisis line which will be in operation in November, Bridge officers have also hired Janice Ayres, an experienced mental health administrator in Clark County for the past three years.

The Bridge counseling program is one of the funded agencies of the Southern Nevada Drug Abuse Council which is using its grant of \$98,000 from the U.S. Office of Education to establish a many-faceted approach to drug problems in the Southern part of the state. Bridge officers, in addition to Lowman, are Dr. Cliff Lawrence, Deputy Superintendent of Schools, vice president; Mrs. Lee Rose, secretary and Hazel E. Adams, C. P. A., treasurer and 35 board members from a cross-section of the business, professional and rehabilitation community serve on the board.
