


# Nevada's Newest Hero

He listed his name as D. B. Cooper as he boarded the commercial jet airplane in Portland, Ore. Using a home-made bomb device he ordered the crew to fly to Seattle where he demanded \$200,000 and four parachutes. The FBI complied with Cooper's request

## AMENDMENT

Intended to be proposed by Mr. JACKSON to H.R. 11731, an Act making appropriations for the Department of Defense for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1972, and for other purposes, viz; On page 49, between lines 21 and 22, insert a new title as follows:
