reason I decided to write you again (you remember me, don't you?) is because we have been going to your town for about 22 YEARS, and are disgusted with the change there - which we discovered last year and it is worse now.

The papers have for some time been crying the blues about Las Vegas business decline and I can tell you that I believe I know why.

First of all we do not have any complaint regarding the Flamingo rooms and anything in that dept. The Reserv. Mgr. - Mrs. Judi Stephens is a doll and has always tried her best for us. We've been going to that hotel for 3 yrs. - 14 yrs. at the Sahara - and have tried every other one but 3.

Now the problem in Vegas is:

1. Poor Food except a few places.
2. Poor service except a few places.
3. TERRIBLE rudeness and sullenness among the dealers - they seem to feel they're doing us a favor just dealing us a few cards.

For instance the other night I sat at a table next to a table that was filled with Spanish speaking women. That's fine, except they were yelling - and so I quietly remarked to a friend sitting with me that the noise was awful and I couldn't concentrate whereupon our dealer who had been sour, dull, sullen, etc. up till then said: 'Lady don't you like the noise, why don't you go to church.' I reported him - this was a "first" for me that night. I never did that before.

Right now we don't care if we never return there - and that's too bad -- after all these years.

Thought you'd like to know this since you are so dedicated to the town. Incidentally congratulations on your appointment on the "Crime Commission." You're a good man and I still love your paper, Shalom.
