Epilepsy Society of the Epilepsy Foundation of America is preparing its annual drive to inform the general

public about epilepsy. Nationwide, about four million people have this neurological dis-order, which often results from head injuries of various kinds. In the Southern Nevada area about 5000 are believed to have epilepsy. Like epileptics everywhere, they face tremendous problems in dealing with the rest of society. These problems are the prime targets of the Epilepsy Society and the educational campaign for all of 1972.

According to Dr. Mark G. Beals, Presi-dent of the Southern Nevada Chapter and head of the Special Education Dept., UNLV, the way the public thinks about epilepsy makes a great deal of difference to the lives of epilepsy patients, "For far too long," he says, "people with epilepsy have faced public hostility based on such mistaken ideas as epilepsy being contagious, that those who have it are mentally retarded, or even insane.
