

JEWISH NEWS BRIEFS

TEL AVIV (WNS)--Israel has sent 500 kilograms of medicine and medical supplies to the Indian Red Cross for the relief of the Bangla Desh refugees. A private group of Israelis recently shipped 500 tons of soya flour to India for the use of refugees.

LOS ANGELES (WNS)--Five thousand people marched through downtown Los Angeles in a candlelight walk on behalf of Soviet Jewish political prisoners.

NEW YORK (WNS)--The Committee on Control and Authorization of Campaigns of the World Zionist Organization has called upon the American Jewish Community to channel all aid to Soviet Jewry through the United Jewish Appeal.

BONN (WNS)--Yad Vashem, the Israeli memorial foundation for Nazi Victims, honored five Germans with awards and citations here, for having saved Jewish lives during the Nazi regime at great risk to themselves.

JERUSALEM (WNS)--Police were investigating a letter to Premier Golda Meir threatening her with death if unauthorized autopsies were not halted.

TEL AVIV (WNS)--Eyal Achikar, a wounded Israeli pilot who had spent nearly 17 months in an Egyptian prison hospital, was exchanged for four Egyptian soldiers and six civilians.

ORTHODOX JEWS HARASS HADASSAH ON AUTOPSY ISSUE

More than 1,000 young Orthodox Jewish activists picketed the New York Hilton Hotel (on Wednesday, December 15), where 2,500 new lifetime members of Hadassah were being honored. The picketers, members of the National Orthodox youth movement Zeirei Agudath Israel of America, were protesting against the continued policy of unauthorized autopsies in the Hadassah Hospital in Jerusalem. The mass picket, which lasted for over three hours included the chant of such slogans as "How Long, Hadassah?" and "Stop It, Now." Police officials on the scene commended the orderly way in which the picket demonstration was held. The demonstrators carried signs saying "Adopt the American

Principle of Prior Consent," "Let Them Rest in Peace, Not Pieces."

A circular distributed at the scene revealed that in a letter dated November 20, 1970, the director of the U.S. State Department Agency for International Development stated that after communicating with Hadassah officials, "they have indicated that Hadassah is fully prepared to adhere to a policy of prior consent." "This assurance," the circular continues, "was given in connection with an

American government grant." A spokesman for Z.A.I. charged that not only did Hadassah fail to live up to this promise, but even abolished the practice of accepting pre-signed objections.

Zeirei Agudath Israel announced after the picket demonstration that it would continue its campaign on this issue, until the Hadassah Hospital in Jerusalem publicly pledges itself to adopt a policy of not per-

forming any autopsy without the informed consent of the next of kin.
