NEW YORK -- Orthodox Jews from twentyseven countries will participate in the Second World Conference of National Synagogue Organizations and Religious Councils in Jerusalem on January 9-12, 1972, it has been announced by Rabbi Joseph Karasick, President of the Union of Orthodox Jewish Congregations of America,

EIN KAREM, JERUSALEM -- Hadassah Hospital Women Volunteers, YA'AL, said farewell to Mrs. Edwin Kenley, the wife of the Administrator of the Anglican Church Property in Jerusalem, who has been transferred to Cyprus.

NEW YORK -- Dr. Emanuel Neumann, retiring veteran American Zionist leader, was honored at a dinner given in his honor marking the conclusion of his 25th year as member of the Executive of the WZO and the Jewish Agency for Israel.

NEW YORK--Construction of a new workshop for the blind was begun last month in Ashdod, Israel's growing southern port city, it was announced this week by Samuel L. Haber, Executive Vice-Chairman of the Joint Distribution Committee,

NEW YORK -- Almost 70 per cent of Israelis feel that a general wage increase in that country is justified now, in spite of the country's high defense costs and difficult economic situation, according to a recent survey of Israeli attitudes by Public Opinion Research of Israel Ltd., the results of which are being released in the United States by the American Jewish Committee.

NEW YORK -- A national organization of "The American Friends of Haifa University" was formally inaugurated, as State Comptroller, Arthur Levitt, was officially installed as Honorary President, by the Chairman of The Board of Governors of Haifa University, Mr. Charles J. Bensley.

TRENTON -- In a significant decision, the Supreme Court of New Jersey has ruled unanimously that the lending of state funds to churchcontrolled colleges is subject to the same constitutional restrictions as outright grants to such sectarian institutions.

NEW YORK -- Jacob Stein, President of the United Synagogue of America, has sharply refuted statements by Dr. Joachim Prinz criticizing the leadership of the American Jewish community as "visibly false" and "totally unfounded."

NEW YORK -- Nine National Orthodox Jewish Organizations joined in expressing their appreciation to the Council of Jewish Federations and Welfare Funds and to its president, Max M. Fisher, "for the important breakthrough with regard to the Hebrew Day School that occurred at the Pittsburgh General Assembly.

ISTANBUL (WNS) -- Two members of the extreme left-wing Turkish Peoples Liberation Army, which is believed to have close ties with Palestinian terrorist groups, have been sentenced to death by a military court for their part in the kidnap-murder of Israeli Consul General Ephraim Elrom last May 22.

NEW YORK (WNS) -- Charging that some Jewish community agencies are "disturbingly unresponsive to the needs of large constit-uencies of Jews," 50 Jewish community leaders met and launched a new national organization -- the Jewish Community Security Council. Dr. Jacob Neusner was elected chairman and Dr. Seymour Siegel of the Jewish Theological Seminary was elected president.
