All these are among the more than 700 lots of surplus equipment the Clark County School District will sell to the highest bidder, starting at 9:00 a.m. Saturday, January 22, at its warehouse behind the Education Center on Flamingo Road.

Other lots include three vehicles guaranteed not to run, numerous student desks and chairs, several teachers' desks that need refinishing, a few used refrigerators and stoves, and even a stray bar stool that came in from somewhere.

Director of Purchasing and Warehousing Joe Klenke lists the con-

dition of the items as "poor to good," and wryly comments that everything has been "thoroughly used" by the students and staff of the school district.

He does not mean, however, that everything offered for sale is junk. Some equipment, like two wood lathes surplused because they lack modern safety features for student use, is in good working order and perfectly suited for the craftsman who knows what he is doing. Some of the furniture is on the surplus list simply because it is cheaper to replace than repair or refinish, but that shouldn't discourage the handyman who isn't interested in costing out his labor.

All items for sale are open for inspection between 9:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m. workdays, January 10-19, at the school district warehouse behind the Education Center on Flamingo Road. Each lot carries a minimum price ranging from \$1.00 to \$100.00, and successful bidders must pay for their merchandise the day of the sale with cash, a cashier's check or certified check.

Everything is sold "as is" and "where is" and purchasers are responsible for removing their equipment as expeditiously as possible.
