

JEWISH NEWS BRIEFS

WASHINGTON (WNS)--In an address to more than 800 persons at a reception in their honor rendered by the Jewish Community Council of Greater Washington, Ruth Alexandrovich Averbuch and her husband, Isalah, said every Jew in the Soviet Union would go to Israel if "the gates were thrown open."

JERUSALEM (WNS)--Three Soviet representatives, including one Jewish professor, have reportedly applied for visas to enter Israel to attend a New Communist Party-sponsored Soviet-Israel Friendship League meeting opening Jan. 21. Israeli officials said there would be no visa problems, even though Israel and the Soviet Union have no diplomatic ties.

NEW YORK (WNS)--Some 2,000 Jews, including heads of yeshivot, and leaders of the Agudath Israel, Mizrachi and the Lubavitcher movement, met at the Beis Medrash Hagadol, the Lower East Side's largest and most historic synagogue, to protest Israel's handling of the "Who is a Jew" issue.

JERUSALEM (WNS)--Some 1,500 Orthodox religious and lay leaders from all over the world, attending the World Conference of Synagogues and Community Organizations, have been attacked by ultra-Orthodox elements and religious moderates.

NEW YORK (WNS)--Michael Shashar, Israeli Consul for Jewish Organizations of the State of Israel, addressing the 57th annual dinner of the Hebrew Institute of Boro Park-Yeshiva Etz Chaim, the second oldest yeshiva in the U.S., which honored Mr. and Mrs. Max Markowitz and Reuben Markowitz, Shashar spoke of the need for "peace and friendly ways" and "abstention from violence" and said "these goals can be reached through Jewish education."

LONDON (WNS)--Anonymous bomb threats forced the cancellation of a formal dinner in honor of Herut leader Menachem Beigin and the cancellation of an assembly that Beigin was to have addressed.

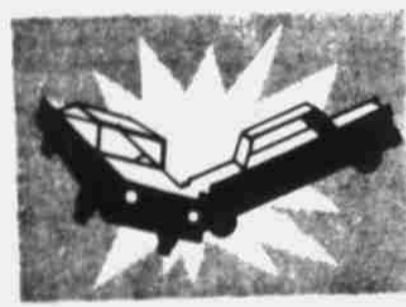
