

AT WORLD ZIONIST CONGRESS IN SESSION

ly broke out during the stormy final session between representatives of Mizrahi and Herut on the one side and Mapam and left-wing Zionists on the other over the insistence by Mapam and their allies that the rights of Palestinian Arabs be recognized and opposition to Herut demands that more Jewish settlements be established in the occupied Arab territories. There were also disturbances when resolutions were adopted "forgiving" the World Union of Jewish Students for their past defections from the Zionist party line.

Louis A. Pincus, who was unopposed, was reelected as chairman of the WZO and was also given the powers of president, though not the title.

JERUSALEM (WNS)

--The World Zionist Congress adopted a resolution requiring Zionist leaders to give their children "A Zionist and Jewish education" in preparation for aliya. It also declared that "a Zionist fulfills his Zionism by aliya to Israel" and said that "no Zionist who fails to impart a Jewish and Zionist education to his children can serve in any office in the Zionist movement." The resolution was opposed by American and other foreign delegates who questioned its constitutionality. The Congress also approved a nearly \$31-million budget for the

World Zionist Organization and a \$19 million budget for the Jewish National Fund.

Immigration Minister Natan Peled told the delegates that Israel was preparing to absorb "hundreds of thousands and even millions of immigrants" during the next eight years. He said most immigrants were "quickly and efficiently" absorbed and accused the press of focusing on the failures.

Ezra Shapiro, world chairman of the Keren Hayesod-United Israel Appeal, said the influx of Soviet Jews into Israel in 1972 will require

"tremendous increases" in expenditures, necessitating a special appeal to raise \$100 million in addition to the "enormous tax burden and compulsory loans" imposed on Israeli citizens. He said "world Jewry must join the Israeli community in hitherto unmatched sacrificial contributions."

Rabbi Mordechai Kaplan, founder of the Reconstructionist Movement, declared "It is doubtful if our people would have continued to exist without the identification between nationality and religion."

He added, "It is up to the secular sector to seek in our tradition moral and spiritual values in order to adapt to them."

Prof. Allen Pollack of New York, of the Labor Zionist Movement, said that all the young members of the various Zionist parties are demanding is a way to integrate those in the 25-40 age bracket into responsible positions in the WZO. He said there was a vacuum within the Zionist movement and what was missing was the continuity between generations.

JEW'S DECRY FIRE-BOMB MURDER

NEW YORK -- The American Jewish Congress issued the following statement by Rabbi Arthur J. Lelyveld of Cleveland, president of the Congress, on the fire-bombing of the offices here of impresario Sol Hurok:

"We are appalled at the abominable attack upon the offices of Sol Hurok. We join in mourning for the life so pointlessly and tragically taken.

"We have no idea who perpetrated this act. We are, aware, however, that there are persons and groups in this community who in the past have condoned and justified the use of precisely this kind of violence.

"They have thus directly and inescapably contributed to the creation of the brutal atmosphere that defiles and distorts much of our public life. They have helped make recourse to violence commonplace.

"No one can be the protagonist of violence without being assessed with responsibility for its result.

"The fact that those who have advocated or defended violence have professed to do so in the name of some high and beneficent purpose -- some purpose that we may all share -- in no way excuses their action or mitigates their responsibility.

"In particular, we are aware there has been some effort to make it appear that the bombing of the Hurok

offices is in some way tied into the cause of Soviet Jewry.

"We do not know the facts. We may yet learn that these bombings have been the work of someone hostile to Soviet Jewry who hoped to discredit legitimate efforts in their behalf.

"One thing we do know. This senseless brutality terribly damages and compromises the fight for Soviet Jews.

"Let it be clear: all of us who have been fighting for years for the release of our brothers in the Soviet Union abhor and condemn this mindless descent into violence.

"We call upon the police of the City of New York to do everything possible to find those guilty of this atrocity. Whoever did this thing, no matter what his motive, must be found and made accountable under our system of law."

In Israel, Jewish Defense League leader

Rabbi Meir Kahane denounced the bombings as "insane" and denied that his organization had anything to do with them, saying "anyone can say 'never again.'" In the U.S. denunciation of the crime and calls for the punishment of those responsible, also came from Philip E. Hoffman, president of the American Jewish Committee, David M. Blumberg, president of the B'nai B'rith and Jacob Stein, vice chairman of the Conference of Presidents of Major Jewish Organizations.
