Hall. Child Haven, a facility for abandoned and neglected tots, was also sponsored and named by him.

Chief Justice Zenoff also sponsors annually the Governor's Cup Jr. Tennis Tournament in Nevada that allows competition only among Nevada boys and girls 17 years old and under.

Zenoff's associate, Cameron Batjer, is expected to file for re-election within two weeks. They are the only members of the court whose terms expire in 1972. It is likely that this election will represent the last of its kind in this state for the merit system of selection together with provisions for discipline of judges is on the ballot for constitutional amendment and is predicted to be passed.

Zenoff, age 55, lives with his wife, Beverly, and daughter, Lisa, 10, at Zephyr Cove in Douglas County. Their son, David Zenoff, Jr., has completed two years at Sierra Junior College and is in hotel and restaurant management training. The Chief Justice selected Monday, January 24, as the day to file, as he has always done at the commencement of each new term, because it is the birthday of his daughter, Terrie Silverman, who is a graduate of Las Vegas High School and Arizona State University, and presently resides in San Francisco with her husband, Stephen.

The Chief Justice is a member of the American and Nevada Bar Associations, served in the U.S. Marine Corps during World War II, was an associate judge on the municipal court bench in Las Vegas, and is a Past President of Kiwanis, Marine Corps League, Temple Beth Shalom and B'nai B'rith. He once served the Nevada State Athletic Commission as a boxing judge and acted in that capacity in nine world championship bouts. He is the recipient of numerous awards for his work in juvenile activities and occasionally lectures at the University of Nevada, usually on the questions of freedom of press, speech and religion.

NEGOTIATION IS THE ANSWER

JERUSALEM (WNS) --Deputy Premier Yigal Allon said that Israel's desire for defensible boundaries and the Arabs' legitimate political demands could both be achieved through negotiations.

Speaking at a festive session of the World Zionist Congress devoted to 75 years of Zionist history, Allon paid tribute to Egyptian President Anwar Sadat. Noting that the Egyptian leader had recently stated that Egypt was prepared to lose a million men in a new war with Israel, but had not given the order to resume shooting, Allon said "his decision to refrain from opening fire was that of a courageous leader concerned with the destiny of his country and people."

In a radio interview Foreign Minister Abba Eban said Israel would "wait and see" what Egypt's position would be in view of the recent demonstrations war by Cairo University students. He said U.S.-Israeli talks were still in progress and that the U.S. was not offering

Phantom jets to Israel in exchange for abandoning positions which Israel feels is necessary for its security.

(In Washington a State Department official said there had been "some progress" on the possibility of "close proximity" talks with Egypt on an interim agreement that would permit the reopening of the Suez Canal.)

(At the United Nations a spokesman announced that UN Middle East peace negotiator Dr. Gunnar V. Jarring visited Senegal and Mauritania late in January to review the findings of the four African presidents who visited Israel and Egypt on an "exploratory" peace mission on behalf of the Organization for African Unity last fall.)
