that "we shall not talk on any concrete things and not on kilometers. He explained: "Finance Minister (Pinhas) Sapir is now in the U.S.A. and he is talking on-something concrete (aid to Israel). If his requests are met I will be very satisfied."

Dayan advised Egyptian President Anwar Sadat to start negotiating so as to prevent internal unrest from boiling over.

Regarding Sadat's latest Moscow visit, Dayan commented: "We are accustomed that any Egyptian leader visiting Moscow comes back ith more arms. it's natural that Sadat would bring back more equipment. I do hope he will not ask active Russian participation in case of a flare-up between Isreal and the Egyptians." Dayan said he hoped the Kremlin would encourage Sadat to seek political, not military, solutions.

Last Defense is Offense

We have been bombarded with phone calls, some from persons close to Hank Greenspun, pointing out what, obviously, we had already spotted.

The Sun publisher started his column stating: "It is not my intention to write anything relative to my personal involvement with the Howard Hughes organization ----." and "What I may say of a personal nature could be considered self-serving so it has no place in this column."
He then continued for 21 paragraphs to

discredit Howard Hughes with the same oftrepeated, frivolous accusations, deliberately dishonest and fraught with deceit. But the picture has changed in the past few days. A suit for \$142,000,000 in damages was

filed Feb. 2 by Hank Greenspun against the Hughes Tool Co.

Since this is a legal action to be determined in a court of law, it is a serious breach of journalistic ethics, especially by the instigator, to plead his case in the newspaper. That is exactly what Greenspun is perpetrating on an unsuspecting public.

This devious scheme to gain public favor for his own personal benefit, does serve one useful purpose. It opens the door for other, honest newspapermen to seek and write the truth, exposing the sinister motives behind the insidious tirade conducted by Greenspun against the billionaire, since the day Robert Maheu was fired in 1970. (Maheu, chief of Nevada operations for Hughes, was ousted after four years at \$10,000 per week, and a slew of other financial benefits.)

Greenspun justifies his right to publish the infamous statements with: "There are still obligations that a newspaper has to keep the ublic informed on matters of vital inter Let us analyze exactly how the L.V. Sun fulfills its obligation to keep the public informed.

In a front page, lead story by Sun Executive Editor Bryn Armstrong, who should know better, the allegations in the complaint by Greenspun are carefully and systematically spelled out. That is, only those that condemn the tool company and those that extoll the virtues of Greenspun.

For instance: The tool company "maliciously, unjustly and unlawfully conspired" to cloud the title of land
