PROBLEMS WITH SOVIET IMMIGRANTS

TEL AVIV (WNS) --The influx of Soviet immigrants has created political and economic problems. With only a small fraction of the immigrants joining the dominant Labor Party, and the great majority joining the right-wing opposition Herut Party or the Orthodox National Religious Party, the political complexion of the country threatens to be upset. At the same time difficulties have been encountered in finding employment for doctors and dentists arriving from the Soviet Union. Health Minister Victor Shemtov said that re-training centers will be set up at every large hospital to retrain medical specialists from un-

wanted to needed medical fields and dentists would be encouraged to establish cooperatives.

RELIGIOUS ZEALOTS JAILED, FINED

JERUSALEM (WNS) --Two religious zealots were found guilty of unlawful assembly and disturbing the peace for participating in violent demonstrations here last July against Sabbath violators.

Magistrate Moshe Shalgi, declaring that "God doesn't need a gendarmerie on earth," sentenced Zvi Greenwald to four months in jail.

The second defendant, a minor, was fined \$120.

Will Real Con Man Please Stand Up

Sun publisher Hank Greenspun should sue Time magazine for naming author Clifford Irving: "Con Man of the Year."

Irving snatched a measly \$650,000, while Greenspun's haul was in the vicinity of \$10,000,000 (that we know of so far.)

Irving had to spend a whole year, concocting stories, forging letters and traveling thousands of miles to meetings in Aztec ruins, obscure motels and the back seat of an automobile. All Greenspun had to do was to know Bob Maheu.

And while the smoke is still clearing, the money Irving glommed (or most of it) is impounded, his wife is under indictment facing extradition to Switzerland, his gay life with beautiful women has been exposed, and the author himself faces a pretty good chance of winding up in jail. Meanwhile Greenspun rides around in a Rolls Royce, has a relative on the payroll at \$1,000 a week, invests \$2,000,000 (he says) in a Henderson real estate promotion and, to top it all, is suing Howard Hughes for another \$142,000,000.

That's what you call "Hutzpah" - a Jewish expression that can best be described with a Henny Youngman one-liner: "You tell a guest your home is his - so he sells it."
